affected by the resurgence of COVID-19 cases, particularly the elderly and vulnerable. May God's healing presence bring comfort and strength to those in need.

We mark Whitsunday (Pentecost) this weekend, on 8 June 2025. This day commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit and the beginning of the Church's mission to the world, as recorded in Acts 2. In the same spirit of advancing the church's mission, the Diocese will be making a special appeal for financial contributions towards supporting and strengthening school chaplaincy work in The Diocese of Singapore.

The work of school chaplaincy involves sharing the gospel to pre-believers, discipling new or un-churched Christian students and mobilising disciplined Christian

students to be active witnesses in the schools.

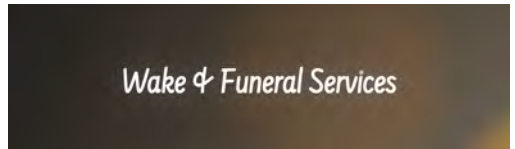
