PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for Yemen, a country that is nestled in the southern corner of the Arabian Peninsula. Although rich in history, it is currently overwhelmed by hardship. Years of civil war, deep poverty, and environmental crisis have left over 80% of its population—more than 25 million people—dependent on humanitarian aid just to survive. Access to clean water is rapidly diminishing as the country's water table dries up, adding to the suffering. Pray that God will intervene and bring lasting resolution to the conflict and that aid will reach those in desperate need. Pray that Jesus will reveal Himself to the people of Yemen and that courageous believers will be protected and strengthened.

SINGAPORE

As schoolchildren in Singapore enjoy their holiday break, let us pray for families to experience meaningful time together, marked by rest, joy, and deeper connection. Pray for safe travels for those going overseas, and for journey mercies wherever they go. Ask the Lord to strengthen the bond of love within families, that homes would be filled with peace and unity. May Christian families be led by the Spirit, growing in faith and modelling Christ's love in all they do.

St Hilda's Church

Pray for good response to their Conference and Family Day which will be held from 8-10 August

- that church members will have a deep hunger for God's Word, that strong bonds of friendship will be forged through joyful fellowship and for church unity to be further strengthened. 
