PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

The 10/40 Window spans from North Africa across the Middle East to Asia, home to billions of people—many of whom have never heard the gospel. This region includes some of the world's most spiritually unreached and resistant nations, where access to the Bible is limited and Christians are often persecuted. Yet even in these places, God is at work through His church, local missionaries, and divine encounters. Let us pray for the spread of the gospel, boldness and protection for believers, and for hearts to be opened to Christ. May God raise up workers, awaken spiritual hunger, and bring revival across this vast and needy region.

SINGAPORE

June marks Men's Mental Health Month, a time to remember and lift up those facing mental distress and illness. Pray especially for men who may suffer in silence—asking God to bring comfort, courage, and access to the medical and emotional support they need. Pray for healing from trauma, anxiety, and depression, and that they may experience God's loving presence in their journey. May the Lord's gentle hand be upon every sufferer—that they may know they are not forgotten, that they are deeply loved by our Heavenly Father.

DIOCESE

Yishun Christian Church (Anglican)

Pray for the Vicar Revd Daniel Teo, priests and staff of the English, Chinese and Tamil congregations, that

they will be continually led and strengthened by the Holy Spirit as they help their church members grow in Christlikeness towards spiritual maturity. Pray that church members will embrace personal brokenness and be open to God for spiritual change, create space for His truth to be understood and applied in community, invest time and effort in forming deep relationships with one another and live out the gospel of God's grace through acts of service and compassion.

Retired Clergy and Deaconesses

Pray that the Lord renew and refresh our retired clergy and deaconesses in a new season of their lives; that they will remain strong in the Lord; that they will have many opportunities to contribute meaningfully to the life of the church and to the advancement of God's Kingdom.

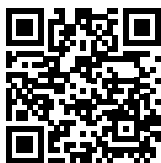

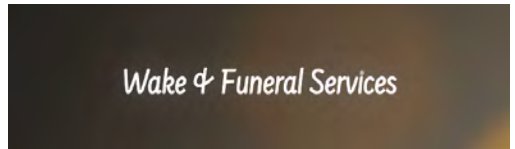

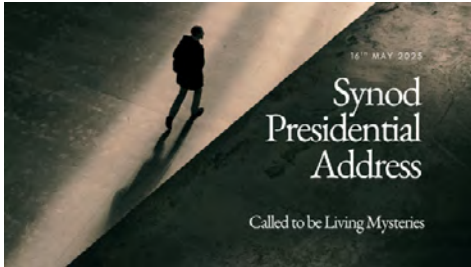
