rom 15-18 June, more than 300 of us gathered in Holiday Villa, JB, for this year's church camp. Guided by Bishop Emeritus Dr Gordon Wong's insightful teaching on John 15:1-17, we reflected together on our camp theme, Abiding in the Love of Christ. Over 4 sessions, Bishop Gordon exhorted us on these key points: (1) Abiding in Christ, (2) Abiding in the Love of Christ, (3) Abiding in the Fruit of the Love of Christ, and (4) Abiding in the Love of Christ: Experiencing Joy. He urged us to grow in our love for Christ and for one another.

His reflection on Jesus's words in v. 7, "If you abide in me, and my words abide in you...", resonated with many of us. The second part of this statement can be understood as allowing the words of Jesus to "be at home in us", and this is a call to immerse ourselves in Scripture. This call, of course, was made to the SAC community at the beginning of the year. I hope that all of us have been progressing well with our Bible reading plans. If not, it's not too late to catch up! Do continue to encourage and share your reflections with one another.



THE VICAR WRITES

Our time together at the camp was both enriching and edifying, and we give thanks for every person who was there! Unfortunately, many of you weren't, and you were missed. We do hope that more of you will be able to join us for our next church camp in 2027!

Looking to the nearer future, we're not many weeks away from the 60th anniversary of Singapore's independence. In conjunction with our SG60 National Day celebrations, SAC will be publishing a special edition of the Courier magazine. This will reflect on the Cathedral's role in Singapore these 60 years, and on how our church has grown together with our nation. As we consider the Lord's blessings upon the life and

ministry of SAC over the past 6 decades, we'll be reminded of many reasons to give thanks to Him.

With that in mind, let's intentionally aside set time to pray for our nation in the coming weeks. LoveSingapore's annual 40.Day Prayer Season commenced on 1 July and will continue until National Day, and I encourage you to use the daily reflections to guide you in interceding for Singapore. May God's kingdom come and His will be done in our nation. All glory to His name!



PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Let us continue to pray for peace to permeate our troubled world. Pray for the ongoing tensions in the Middle East, particularly between Israel and Iran, and the humanitarian crisis in Gaza. The region remains highly volatile, with rising violence and countless innocent lives caught in the crossfire. Pray for a de-escalation of conflict, wisdom for leaders, protection for civilians, and renewed efforts toward peace and reconciliation. Remember Asia, where several nations are facing political instability and unrest. In Myanmar, violence continues under military rule. In Thailand, recent political tensions have led to mass protests and fears of a government collapse. May the peace of our Lord Jesus Christ shine through these lands, and may more people have the opportunity to learn about Him and come to know Him as their personal Saviour.

SINGAPORE

As we begin the countdown to Singapore's 60th National Day, we give thanks to God for His gracious hand upon our nation. We pray that Singapore will be a nation that honours and glorifies God. May we not rely solely on our human achievements or material success, but humbly acknowledge that "every good and perfect gift is from above" (James 1:17). Pray especially for the Church in Singapore. May we remain faithful to the gospel, be bold in our witness, and generous in our service. Ask God to use the Church as a blessing to the nation — reaching the lost, healing the broken, and discipling the next generation to love God and love people. (Psalm 33:12)

Pray for unity in the leadership team and for the pastoral team to live out Scripture in obedience to Christ, with the power of the Spirit and in the love of the Father. Pray that the parish work in close union with St Margaret's School (Primary) to minister to students, staff, and parents. Pray also that the parish be diligent in support and encouragement to its mission focus in the Deanery of Cambodia.

Pray also for the healing and restoration of families going through hurt and pain.






