Ask God to guide the U.S. government in pursuing trade policies that are just and balanced—promoting economic stability, fairness, and peace across nations.

SINGAPORE

Singapore continues to combat against the rising use of e-cigarettes and vaping, especially among the youth. With thousands caught in possession, the government is responding through enforcement, education, and support programmes to curb this harmful trend. Pray for protection over our youths, for wisdom and perseverance among authorities as they seek effective solutions, and for healing and breakthrough for those struggling with addiction.

DIOCESE

Pray for the vicars, pastors, staff teams and

lay leaders of St John's Chapel, St Matthew's Church and St Paul's Church, that they will have divine wisdom, grace and perseverance to lead and shepherd the respective flocks entrusted to their care. Pray for members to have deep spiritual hunger and longing for God, to seek Him, walk closely with Him in obedience to His Word and to serve Him with undivided hearts. Pray that, being united in love and vibrant in witness, they will be reflections of God's love and light to the communities around them.




LEGACY GIVING
