Let us lift up Ukraine before the Lord: praying that leaders will act with wisdom and integrity, and that the vulnerable will find protection and comfort.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our national servicemen as they train in their various vocations to defend our country. May God protect them and keep them safe. For those who have just enlisted, pray that they will adjust well to the new regimen, developing resilience and confidence. May they be strengthened in body, mind, and spirit, learning their roles with diligence. As they face challenging obstacles, may the grace of God go before them, enabling them to persevere and overcome.

DIOCESE

Deanery of Indonesia

Pray for Heidi Li as she settles in St Andrew's School, Kuatnana, that the Lord protect her, grant her good health and help her adjust to

living in the school dormitory. Pray for wisdom to plan the nursing curriculum and train the locals to teach the nursing course, at the Vocational High School in Nursing. Pray for the establishment of a Nursing Academy in Kuatnana for graduates from the Vocational High School in Nursing to attain a Diploma in Nursing and for the purchase of a suitable property for the construction of a campus block. Pray also for the purchase of land to construct a Junior High School and a Senior High School in Sorong (the provincial capital West Papua), for the marginalised and poor Papuan tribe living at the outskirts of the city.




