PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Malaysia marks its National Day on 31st August. We pray for Malaysia's ties with Singapore, that mutual respect and cooperation will continue to strengthen between our nations. Pray for Malaysia's national unity and wellbeing, that peace will prevail among its diverse ethnic and religious communities. Lift up their Prime Minister, Cabinet, and Parliament that they may govern with wisdom, fairness, and integrity. Pray also for the economy, that the nation may withstand global challenges, ease the burdens of rising costs, create good jobs, and support the poor and marginalized. Finally, we pray for the Malaysian Church that it will be a blessing to the nation as they bear witness to Christ.

SINGAPORE

Pray that our schools may remain safe with nurturing environments where bullying and harmful habits such as vaping have no place. May God protect our students from negative influences, granting them courage to stand against peer pressure. May teachers, counsellors, and school leaders be given wisdom, patience, and effective strategies to guide and mentor their students, while parents remain vigilant, loving, and engaged in their children's lives.

DIOCESE

Pray for the new St Andrew's Community Hospital (Bedok) with 100 rehabilitation beds and 140 transitional care beds, that the patients will experience healing of body, soul and spirit. Pray for

the increasing mental health needs in Singapore, that the Psychiatric Services arm of our Singapore Anglican Community Services will be able to meet the greater demand for psychiatric rehabilitation services. Pray that the Autism Services of St Andrew's Mission Hospital will be able to advocate for the inclusion of people with autism into our society, raise the capability of the students in our two special schools, provide meaningful support for the adults in our two day activity centres and adult home, and develop the Chapel of Christ our Hope (Siglap) to be a testimony of God's love. Pray for wisdom, favour and resources to develop the St Andrew's Senior Care and Active Ageing Centres into communities of faith, hope and love for seniors, as Singapore becomes a super-aged society (where >20% are aged 65 years and above) by 2026.

CATHEDRAL

Let us pray for all candidates who have enrolled in the Baptism classes beginning this September, that these sessions will help them deepen their understanding of God's Word and strengthen their relationship with our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Pray that they will be shielded from distractions or hurdles that may hinder their participation, and that their hearts will remain open and receptive to God's leading. We also pray for the instructors and facilitators, that the Lord grant them wisdom, patience, and joy in their teaching. May this time of preparation be a time where all are richly blessed, where faith is strengthened and lives are transformed for His glory.




