PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for the people of the Philippines affected by the recent earthquake. May God's comfort be with those who have lost loved ones, and may He grant healing to the injured, and strength to workers involved in rescue and relief efforts. Pray for the light of Christ to shine through amid the sadness, and for resources to enable the rebuilding of homes and infrastructure in the devastated communities. Continue to pray for the tense situation in the Middle East. We commit to the Lord the mediation efforts in Egypt between Israel and Hamas. Pray for the leaders to engage in honest negotiations with a heart for their people. May the Lord protect civilians caught in the conflict, and may the hostages be released as soon as possible.

SINGAPORE

Pray for the strengthening of Singapore's ties with Australia and New Zealand. We give thanks for the longstanding friendship between our nations and pray for continued cooperation in meaningful and mutually supportive ways, in areas such as education, trade, regional stability, and shared values. May God guide our leaders with wisdom and goodwill, and deepen the trust and understanding across these partnerships.

Pray for the Jurong church plant that has just started and for divine strategies to reach out to the communities in the west. Pray also that the church's outreach efforts to her neighbouring communities will bear much fruit, especially during the coming
