PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Wars around the world and foreign intervention have an impact on Singapore's domestic politics. In a more connected world, having access to information as well as misinformation on every conflict can create fault lines in our society. To counter these threats, there is a need to continuously build bonds between different racial and religious groups. Thank God for the racial and religious harmony we have built up over the past 60 years. Pray that our social cohesion will remain strong in a divided world and may God guide us in fostering peace, mutual respect, and unity among all communities in Singapore.

Pray for God to strengthen, heal and restore marriages in need of mending, that married couples may rediscover intimacy, joy and love in Christ. Pray
