And may we, His Church, be moved with compassion to give generously, to serve faithfully, and to speak up for justice. Pray for God's provision to reach places where the need is greatest, and may His mercy bring hope to the hungry and peace to the broken.

SINGAPORE

In recent news, we have been confronted with heartbreaking stories: children suffering from abuse, families in crisis, and lives broken by reckless choices. These remind us how deeply our world needs God's mercy and renewal. Let us pray for healing and protection over every child and every victim of abuse. Pray that hearts would turn away from sin and return to the Lord, our source of hope and restoration. May God strengthen our families and communities to defend the vulnerable and to walk in righteousness. And may the Church shine brightly in these times, offering hope, compassion, and truth to a hurting world.

DIOCESE

Pray for our Archbishop The Most Revd Dr Titus Chung as he provides leadership and oversight to the Diocese of Singapore's 27 local parishes, 7 deanery countries, 11 schools, 18 preschools and 42 healthcare and community services under the Singapore Anglican Community Services and St Andrew's Mission Hospital, in addition to his roles and responsibilities in the wider Body of Christ. Pray for divine guidance, wisdom, and strength to fulfil God's mandate for our Diocese in these difficult and challenging times. Pray also for strong collaborations as our Diocesan office holders, staff, clergy and laity unite to build and strengthen God's Church and to advance His Kingdom.
