THE WORLD

Pray for Ukraine. As the war in Ukraine continues to cause widespread destruction and fear, especially following recent strikes on civilian areas in Kyiv, we lift up all who are suffering. Pray for God's protection over innocent lives, comfort for grieving families, and healing for the wounded. May the Lord strengthen all who are working tirelessly to provide emergency aid, shelter, and care. Pray for peace to take root, and for God to grant wisdom to world leaders in their efforts to seek justice, stability, and a path toward ending the violence.

We also remember Sudan, one of the poorest countries in the world, which is facing humanitarian collapse due to renewed violence. Pray for safety and provision for those fleeing the conflict, healing for survivors, and comfort to all who mourn loved ones. Pray that God's presence and power will reign in this nation, and may He grant wisdom and compassion to international leaders and humanitarian organisations working to protect lives and restore hope.

SINGAPORE

Let us lift up in prayer those who are coping with unemployment, job transitions, or financial uncertainty. May the Lord draw near to those who feel discouraged or anxious in this season. Pray that God, our Provider, will open new doors. May He surround them with supportive relationships, practical help, and the assurance that they are not alone. We ask for peace to calm their minds,

strength to sustain them each day, and renewed hope in His faithful plans.

DIOCESE

For the Deanery of Indonesia, we praise God for the Consecration of St Andrew's School Kuantana by Archbishop Dr Titus Chung and the official opening of the School on 15 November 2025. Pray for the recruitment of quality teachers for St Andrew's School Kuantana to elevate the academic standards of the students. Pray also for strength, grace and wisdom for Ms Heidi Li as she develops the curriculum for the vocational nursing high school.
