PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

As the G20 meeting concludes, we pray that world leaders will follow through with concrete action on the discussions and commitments made. May their decisions not remain as words alone, but become meaningful steps that bless the nations and promote global wellbeing. In a rapidly changing geopolitical landscape, we ask the Lord to guide countries in building new and healthy partnerships, connecting regions, blocs, and like-minded economies in ways that are mutually beneficial. Pray for the forging of deep, trusting friendships among nations, so that the world may grow more peaceful, cooperative, and united. We also pray that world leaders will treat the climate crisis with the seriousness it demands. taking practical and urgent action to address rising risks. We lift up vulnerable nations such as Jamaica, Cuba, and Tuvalu, which are deeply affected by climate threats. May they find strong partners, sufficient support, and lasting solutions that bring protection, resilience, and hope.

SINGAPORE

We lift up to the Lord those who are struggling with addiction to drugs, gambling, pornography, vaping, digital dependency or other harmful habits. May God grant them courage and resolve to break free from what holds them captive. We pray that they will not have to suffer in silence, but have ready access to help, counselling, and supportive communities that can walk with them on the road to recovery. May the grace of our Lord and His love draw them toward repentance, renewal, and the rebuilding of their lives.

DIOCESE

Pray that the Psychiatric Services arm of our Singapore Anglican Community Services will be able to meet the greater demand for psychiatric rehabilitation services in Singapore. Pray that the Autism Services of St Andrew's Mission Hospital will be able to advocate for the inclusion of people with autism into our society, raise the capability of the students in our two special schools, provide meaningful support for the adults in our two-day activity centres and adult home, and develop the Chapel of Christ our Hope (Siglap) to be a testimony of God's love. Pray for wisdom, favour and resources to develop the St Andrew's Senior Care and Active Ageing Centres into communities of faith, hope, and love for seniors, as Singapore becomes a super-aged society (where >20% are aged 65 years and above) by 2026.

CATHEDRAL

As Missions Month draws to a close, we pray that the call to missions will continue to burn deeply in the hearts of our Cathedral family. May the Great Commission remain central to our identity and purpose as believers, not only during this season, but throughout our lives. Ask the Lord to show us how we can take part in His mission in our daily lives. May He stir us to obedience, and guide us to opportunities where His love can be made known through our words and actions. May our Cathedral continue to be a sending, serving, and witnessing community, faithful to God's heart for the nations.




