## **PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS**

#### THE WORLD

We lift Hong Kong to the Lord as the city mourns the tragic fire and the many lives lost. We pray that God's comfort will surround the families who are grieving and those shaken by the disaster. May His presence bring peace in the midst of deep sorrow. We ask the Lord to heal the injured and those suffering emotional trauma, and for the swift provision of support to residents who have been displaced or who have lost their possessions. We remember the firefighters, medical teams, and volunteers who responded under great pressure, that God may strengthen and renew them. May Hong Kong experience unity, compassion, and hope through the grace and mercy of our Heavenly Father.

#### SINGAPORE

We lift Singapore to the Lord, praying especially for our government and those entrusted with leadership. May God grant them wisdom, as they make decisions that shape the nation's future. We also pray for Singapore's relationships with other nations, that God may continue to bless us with favour in diplomacy, stability in partnerships, and opportunities for Singapore to contribute among nations. In this holiday season, we remember families who are travelling. We pray for safety and protection over every journey. May this time be filled with rest, joy, and meaningful moments. We ask that God strengthen family bonds, and bring renewal and togetherness to every household.

#### DIOCESE

#### Parish of Christ Church

Pray for the parish to be a Discipling Community (her 10year focus since 2020) and for members to actively engage in the discipleship process with the aim of raising disciple makers. Pray for divine strategies and boldness to reach out to residents of the new HDB blocks around the parish and for the outreach efforts in Pek Kio and Little India to

bear much fruit. Pray for their local missionaries to Nepal. Mr. & Mrs. Sandrabose, and that Christ Church Pokhara may be able to purchase land for a church building. Pray for wisdom as the parish continues to support mission agencies and missionaries in India who are going through challenging times. Pray also for the many migrant workers attending Sunday services at St Andrew's Migrant Workers Medical Center, to receive the good news.

#### Chapel of the Holy Spirit

Pray for the Holy Spirit's leading in the planning and organisation of the church's two Christmas outreaches on 20 & 21 Dec; that the outreach to the elderly on 20 Dec will be well attended, and that the message of Christmas will minister to their hearts and draw them to the Saviour. For the evangelistic outreach on 21 Dec, pray especially that the students of St Andrew's Secondary school will respond positively to the invitation to come; that the songs played by the Christian Orchestra will touch many hearts and that God's word will be well received. For these two Christmas outreaches, pray for a mighty harvest of souls.

We lift up the Christmas activities at our Cathedral. praying that every effort and plan may proclaim the love of Christ. May everyone who comes to our Cathedral to visit or participate in these activities feel His presence through our love, and may they come to know Him more deeply. 
