May the peace of Christ cover the land and all its people. and may His love and grace protect, restore, and heal them.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our Prime Minister, Mr Lawrence Wong, and his team, that God's wisdom will guide them as they steward Singapore's economy amid global uncertainties and international tensions. May Singapore continue to thrive despite the effects of US tariffs and the wider challenges impacting many nations. We seek the Lord's favour to grant our leaders clarity and discernment as they navigate slower growth, rising geopolitical friction, and an increasingly complex world. Pray that our nation will remain resilient and united, and that in every season, God's provision, peace, and guidance will uphold and protect Singapore.
