

We pray for protection from further harm, wisdom for authorities as investigations continue, and for God's peace to prevail as these communities and nations seek healing. restoration, and hope.

As we enter the week leading to Christmas, we pray for the world, that every nation and its people may pause and be still before God and rest in His peace and steadfast love. We ask the Lord to grant His protection to all the faithful as they gather for worship during the Christmas season. In a wounded world, may the Church shine as a light, leading all people to Jesus Christ, Emmanuel, God with us.

SINGAPORE

Pray for all migrant workers and foreign domestic workers in Singapore, especially during this year-end season, as many are far from home. We thank the Lord for their service, and ask for His blessing on each of them. Pray also for their families back home, that they may remain united in love even across the miles, and that God's grace would abound in their lives.

DIOCESE

Pray for our Diocese as we prepare to celebrate the birth of Christ, that God will bless the various evangelistic outreaches and services in our parishes, located in Singapore and in the Deanery countries. Pray that many will be drawn into God's house and will encounter Christ during this Christmas season. Pray for God's word to go forth with power and authority, for open doors of opportunity to boldly share the gospel, that many will experience Christ's love and find in Him. the hope of salvation.

Pray that God would inspire our Cathedral members and raise up volunteers to serve as Sunday School teachers in the children's ministry.
