THE WORLD

We thank the Lord for the ceasefire agreement between Cambodia and Thailand, bringing a halt to the recent border clashes. Let us pray that relations between the two nations will be restored, and trust rebuilt between their leaders and the peoples. Pray for the safe return of soldiers to their home countries and for both sides to faithfully uphold the terms of the agreement. May this ceasefire open the way for displaced families along the border to return home safely, and resume their livelihoods. We also ask for the Lord's blessing upon Cambodia and Thailand, that He would grant peace, healing, and hope for their future.

SINGAPORE

As children and youths return to school after the holidays, we commit them into the Lord's loving care. We ask for His favour and blessing over each child, that they may begin the new academic year with enthusiasm, confidence, and an appetite to learn. We pray for wisdom, patience, and joy for all principals and teachers, that they would return with renewed strength and purpose to nurture and guide the students entrusted to them. We also ask for the Lord's protection over every school, that classrooms may be safe. May each child and youth experience joy in learning, grow in character, and develop resilience and confidence for the year ahead.

DIOCESE

For Westside Anglican Church and Jurong Anglican Church, we pray for the church leaders to seek God first in all things, trusting in His guidance and provision. Pray that they will have humble and teachable hearts and lead by serving and reflecting the character of Christ. For church staff, pray that they will serve with diligence, faithfulness and joy, honouring God in every task. Pray for wisdom, patience, and strength as they support the ministries and mission of the church. Pray that church members grow in love for God and for one another, living out their faith practically; and for spiritual maturity, a hunger for God's Word, and a life of prayer and worship. Pray that they will be a blessing to their families, workplaces, and communities, reflecting Christ in all they do.
