THE VICAR WRITES

REVD CHRISTOPHER CHAN



You might have noticed that I've been speaking a lot on prayer. The repetition is intentional, as I'm addressing a matter of *utmost* importance in the life of our church. And so, to borrow the words of the apostle Peter, I would like to stir you up by way of reminder (cf. 2 Peter 1:13) to move into a higher gear in our personal and corporate prayer life this year.

Let us grow in our personal prayer life.

I urge you to set aside time daily to commune with God; spend time in prayer and keep up your Bible reading. Delight in His presence. Meditate on His Word. Listen to His voice. Develop a habit of journalling, as this can help you discern how God is speaking to you. The SAC prayer journal is now on sale in the Welcome Centre, and I encourage you to use it to enrich your devotional life!

Let us grow in our corporate prayer life.

We need to spend more time praying together, especially through our church prayer meeting. When I started going to church as a youth, we had a prayer meeting on Saturdays at 1.30pm, which some refer to as the post-lunch graveyard shift! There

were times when I felt reluctant to attend the prayer meeting, but every time that I was there, I was blessed! I felt refreshed, and the time was never wasted. Nowadays, there are still moments when I don't feel particularly enthusiastic about praying, but God has revealed Himself too many times through corporate prayer for me to doubt that something good will happen when we come together to seek His face.

Our next Prayer & Praise meeting will be held on Friday, 23 January. In faith that the turnout will be much higher than it has been in the past, we'll be moving the meeting from the Prayer Halls to the Cathedral New Sanctuary, and I hope that the change of venue will be permanent! We'll commence the meeting at 7.14pm. This peculiar start time was inspired by 2 Chronicles 7:14, which reads: "If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land." This verse instructs us regarding the importance of prayer and the posture we must take as we come before God. I pray that it will convict you to come and be part of our church's "engine room"!

Charles Spurgeon astutely said: "I know of no better thermometer to your spiritual temperature than this, the measure of the intensity of your prayer." May our prayer life, both personal and corporate, be indicative of hearts that are truly on fire for God!



PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

We grieve with the families of those who perished in the devastating fire that broke out in the ski resort town of Crans-Montana, Switzerland, during New Year's Eve celebrations. We pray for the Lord's comfort, and ask that His presence and peace surround them during this time of deep loss. We also remember those who were injured, praying for God's healing touch upon their burns, and that they will be able to access good medical care, for a full and speedy recovery. We also lift up the nation of Venezuela before the Lord in this time of unrest and uncertainty. We pray for the peace that comes from God alone to guard the hearts and lives of its people. May world leaders act with wisdom, humility, and restraint, seeking justice and walking in the ways that lead to peace. We remember all who have been injured or distressed by these events, and ask the Lord to be close to the broken-hearted. In His mercy, may God turn hearts away from violence, restore order and stability, and bring healing and hope to the land.

SINGAPORE

We lift up the many older Singaporeans who, even in their later years, continue working to support themselves and their families. We pray for the Lord's protection over them as they travel to and from work; for strength, dignity, and safety in their daily tasks; and for a safe and comfortable home environment. We also thank God for the social support schemes and efforts to help senior workers and for the age-friendly services in the community. Above all, we pray that these precious elders will have opportunities to hear the gospel and come to know Christ as their Lord and Saviour. May outreach missions and caring

ministries reach into their lives, and may God's mercy and love find them.

DIOCESE

Pray for unity as the Vicar and his team move the different congregations in Church of Our Saviour to align with the church's theme "better together." Pray for smooth planning and preparation for the church's 70th anniversary programmes; for fruitful outreaches by the Chinese and dialect ministries during Chinese New Year; for growth in their Jurong Church Plant and for effective outreach to the community.

For the Chinese Congregation of Church of the Good Shepherd, pray that they may be aligned with the will of God in all that they do. Pray that the staff of the English Congregation will settle into their new portfolios, and for the church to embrace the call for gospel-centred discipleship and missions in 2026.

CATHEDRAL

We take to heart the call of Scripture that was read to us at the recent Covenant Service to "devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful" (Colossians 4:2). We pray that the Lord will help us to commit ourselves to a regular and faithful life of prayer, not only for our own needs, but also for our families, friends, and the wider community around us. May we grow into a praying people who learn to wait upon God, to listen for His voice, and to remain watchful and thankful in all circumstances. May every member of our Cathedral be shaped and formed by a life of prayer, so that our hearts, our actions, and our witness increasingly reflect the love and grace of Christ.
