THE WORLD

Pray for the rising tensions between nations over recent tariff threats, land, and national sovereignty, particularly affecting the people of Greenland and parts of Europe. We ask for wisdom and restraint among world leaders, for peaceful dialogue amid disagreement, and for the protection and dignity of communities caught in the middle. May God guide all involved towards understanding, cooperation, and paths that lead to fairness in trade and social peace.

SINGAPORE

Pray for children with special needs in Singapore, that they may be welcomed, supported, and given a meaningful place in our society. We ask for wisdom and unity among families, communities, service providers, and authorities, that together we may nurture each child's gifts and help them flourish. We pray also for parents and caregivers, that God would grant them patience, strength, and access to the support and resources needed for their children to thrive in an inclusive community.

DIOCESE

Pray for the Deans, Home Base Coordinators, missionaries, and pastors of churches in the Deaneries of Laos and Nepal, that God will envision them, grant them wisdom and courage to plant new churches, raise up local leaders, and advance His Kingdom. Pray that the gospel will continue to be boldly proclaimed even in the midst of challenges, that God's people will be strengthened in faith, and that many in these nations will encounter our risen Lord and be transformed by His mighty power.

CATHEDRAL

Pray for our Cathedral cell groups, that the Lord would bless each group with unity, love, and mutual encouragement in prayer and fellowship. May He inspire creative ways to deepen engagement, grow understanding of Scripture, and spur one another on in faith. We also lift up cell leaders and assistant leaders, asking that they be strengthened, encouraged, and nurtured as they shepherd their groups.




