# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



## THE WORLD

In a time of global tension, we pray for peace among nations and for wisdom, humility, and restraint among world leaders. May God guide the nations towards cooperation and raise up leaders who fear the Lord and lead with fairness and integrity. We remember before the Lord those nations which are most vulnerable, asking Him to protect and sustain them. As a church, we place our hope in the Lord and press on in unceasing prayer, which is our calling, trusting that He works through our prayers to bring peace, justice, and healing to the nations, and that His light and love will shine even in the darkest places.

## SINGAPORE

Pray for Singapore amid falling fertility rates and the long-term implications for families, the workforce, and the nation's future. Pray for wisdom for our government leaders, employers, and communities to create environments where families are supported, children are welcomed, and caregiving is honoured.

Pray also for grace and unity as immigration remains crucial to sustaining the economy and society. Pray for healthy integration marked by openness and mutual respect. Ask that newcomers would be received with a warm welcome, and that social cohesion would

deepen as people of different backgrounds learn to live, work, and flourish together as one people.

## DIOCESE

Pray for our Archbishop The Most Revd Dr Titus Chung as he provides pastoral leadership and oversight to the Diocese of Singapore's 27 local parishes, 7 deanery countries, 11 schools, 18 preschools and 42 healthcare and community services under the Singapore Anglican Community Services and St Andrew's Mission Hospital. Pray that God direct his steps, grant him wisdom, strength and boldness to follow our Lord's leading, serving Him with perseverance and complete devotion. Pray for Spirit-led collaborations with partners in the gospel within Singapore and beyond, that the church may fulfil God's mandate and advance His Kingdom.

## CATHEDRAL

Pray for our Cathedral cell groups, that the Lord would bless each group with unity, love, and mutual encouragement in prayer and fellowship. May He inspire creative ways to deepen engagement, grow understanding of Scripture, and spur one another on in faith. We also lift up cell leaders and assistant leaders, asking that they be strengthened, encouraged, and nurtured as they shepherd their groups.




