THE WORLD

As measles infections rise again in several regions of the world and a Nipah virus outbreak has been reported in South Asia, let us remember in prayer the children, families, and communities affected. Pray for God's mercy to stem the spread of these diseases, for healing for those who are ill, and for protection over vulnerable populations. We uphold healthcare workers, scientists, and public health leaders in prayer as they work to contain infections. We remember communities affected by recent disasters; families in Madagascar recovering from cyclone and flooding, those in Chile and Argentina facing destructive wildfires, and residents in Sicily displaced by landslides. Pray for comfort for the grieving, provision for those who have lost homes and livelihoods, protection for the vulnerable, and strength for relief workers as they bring aid and medical relief to the victims.

SINGAPORE

We thank the Lord for the release of Budget 2026 and for His faithful provision over Singapore in the midst of global uncertainty. We praise Him that many families, seniors, and lower-income households will receive needed support, and that our nation is able not only to weather present challenges but also to look ahead, investing in areas such as AI and future business growth. As we experience these blessings, may we not take them for granted. May the Lord guard us from pride in our economic surplus or trust in our own wisdom. May He grant our Prime Minister Mr Lawrence Wong and his team integrity and

discernment as they steward what has been entrusted to them, and keep our hearts humble, grateful, and always dependent on Him alone.

DIOCESE

Pray for the Vicar Revd Daniel Teo and his staff team as they shepherd the flock in Yishun Christian Church (Anglican) to grow in Christlikeness towards spiritual maturity, by embracing personal brokenness and an openness to God for spiritual change, by creating a space for His truth to be understood and applied, by investing time and effort in deep formational relationships and by living out the gospel of God's grace through acts of service and compassion.

Pray also for the retired clergy and deaconesses in our Diocese, that they may embrace God's gifts to them in a different season of their lives and continue to serve Him faithfully with the strength that He gives, and for the glory of His Name!






