THE WORLD

Pray for Indonesia, home to the largest Muslim population in the world. While the Church is growing in some regions, many communities still remain unreached with the good news of Jesus Christ. May the Holy Spirit open doors where they seem closed, soften hearts, and strengthen His Church to bear faithful witness with love and courage. May the Lord surround pastors, missionaries, and church workers with His protection, refresh them in their weariness, and grant them fruit from their labour in due season. Remember also our neighbour Malaysia, which is experiencing a rise in tuberculosis cases. Pray for protection over communities, especially the vulnerable. May the Lord grant healthcare workers endurance, wisdom, and the resources needed to contain and reduce the spread of the disease.

SINGAPORE

Strong families are a precious foundation for our nation. Pray that the Lord will guard and preserve the sanctity of marriage and grant parents patience and wisdom as they raise their children. Pray also that children, in turn, will honour their parents and faithfully care for them in their later years. Remember our children and youths who are at risk. Pray that the Lord will

shield them from harmful influences and abuse, and provide timely support, safe homes, and caring mentors. May His gracious hand rest upon their lives, bringing healing and restoration in body, mind, and spirit.

DIOCESE

For the Deanery of Vietnam, pray for the Lord to raise up and send workers into the growing harvest field across Vietnam; for the preparation work being done to establish an Anglican Centre for Theological Studies (ACTS) in Ho Chi Minh City and for the formation and development of local leaders to sustain the Deanery's long-term future. Pray also for wisdom and fruitfulness in current and future church planting efforts across the Deanery.

CATHEDRAL

As we prepare for the Cathedral's Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 19 April 2026, pray for the organising team as they make the necessary arrangements. Ask the Lord to grant clarity, unity, and wisdom in every detail. Pray that God will raise up faithful and capable individuals to serve in the Parochial Church Council. May those whom He is calling be willing to step forward in humble service, for the strengthening of the Cathedral and the glory of Christ.






