PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Let us continue to remember the Middle East, where tensions remain high and the threat of further conflict weighs heavily upon the region. Pray for God's mercy upon the peoples of the region, including the soldiers, that lives may be protected and communities spared from further suffering. May the Lord grant wisdom and restraint to national leaders and decision-makers, enabling them to carefully consider the cost of every action and to seek paths that preserve life rather than deepen conflict. Even in times of uncertainty, we trust in the Lord's sovereign plans and purposes. May His will prevail, and may we remember that He continues to work in the affairs of the world. Pray that the Christian community will remain united and steadfast in prayer, standing in the gap and faithfully interceding for peace to return to our troubled world.

SINGAPORE

Pray for the Lord's continued watch over Singapore and our neighbouring nations, especially in light of the ongoing conflict in the Middle East and its wider impact on our region. May He grant wisdom and discernment to our government leaders as they respond to the challenges arising from the conflict. Pray for wisdom in addressing the economic pressures that may arise, including rising oil prices and their effect on the cost of everyday necessities. May the Lord grant fresh ideas and wise strategies so that livelihoods will be protected and disruptions to daily life kept to a minimum. Remember especially lower-income households, asking that their needs

will be provided for and that they may receive timely support. We also remember Singapore citizens and residents who are still waiting to return home from the Middle East. Pray for the Lord's protection over them and for a swift and safe journey back. May His peace guard their hearts during this uncertain time, and may His gracious hand bring them safely home.

DIOCESE

For St Andrew's City Church, pray for unity and grace in their partnership in the gospel, with St Peter's Church, that the Lord would strengthen this relationship for His glory and the advancement of His kingdom. Pray that the Lord would stir the hearts of the young people, leading them to respond to His call and to pursue a deeper walk and greater devotion to Him. Pray that as the parish journeys through the sermon series on the Book of Judges, the Lord would grow His people in Christlikeness.

CATHEDRAL

Pray for all our Cathedral staff who serve faithfully across the various ministries. We give thanks to the Lord for calling them into His service, and ask that He will bless them as they devote themselves to the work He has entrusted to them. May the Lord grant them wisdom, strength, and joy in their daily responsibilities, and may they continually experience His presence as they serve. Pray also that their spiritual lives will grow and deepen, and that they will discover an ever richer fellowship and a closer walk with our Lord.




