

The DEEPER Life: ACEPT HIS LOVE

Advent and Christmas are times of love. I challenge us all not to miss the true story of love this season. The story of true, faithful, unending, sacrificial love. God's love in sending Jesus is the one love that changes everything.

Love has been God's story from the beginning. From the moment creation, God's love was part of the fabric of our world. God's love was in the Garden of Eden both before and after sin entered the world. God showed His love throughout the Old Testament in the lives of people like Moses, Noah, David, and Isaiah just to name a few. Then His love turned the world inside out when He sent His Son to live among us-the God of the universe to be born in a stable, die on the cross, and rise again from the grave. God's love was sent to disrupt and overturn the power of death and evil.

Think about this, the God of the universe loves you so much that He left everything to be with you, to sacrifice His life that you could be with Him. So, what do we do with this gift of love?

God loved the world. He gave His Son. When we accept that gift and believe in Him, we are given His life-salvation and eternal life. Many of you may know exactly what I'm talking about because you have accepted this gift of love somewhere in the past. However, some of you may not have experienced the acceptance of His love for you through His Son Jesus Christ. No matter what challenges or hurts you hold, God's love can handle them and heal them. Wherever you are as you are reading this, I encourage you to accept the gift of God's love. Let this season of Advent be one of accepting the love and salvation God offers in His Son.

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Health minister of Korea has declared Seoul a COVID-19 war zone. Seoul and its environs house half the country's population and contain most of the recent infections. The country's medical system is also under stress with very limited ICU beds available nationwide. Pray for the government to take quick and effective action to tighten safe management measures and close public places to curtail local transmissions. Pray also for the safety of healthcare personnel and for an increased capacity in the healthcare system to cope with the number of infections.

The Democratic Republic of Congo is facing a political crisis sparked by months of political deadlock between supporters of President Felix Tshisekedi and former President Joseph Kabila in the coalition government. Kabila's party commands the majority of parliamentary seats. President Tshisekedi has warned that if he failed to form a new coalition he might be forced to dissolve parliament and hold fresh elections. Kabila's party called the President's decision to scrap the coalition "unconstitutional". Pray for a peaceful resolution to this conflict which, if unresolved, may have serious and adverse consequences on the economy and security in the country, amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

SINGAPORE

Pray for divine favour and good organisation as Singapore prepares to host the World Economic Forum Special Annual Meeting (from 13-16 May 2021); for the safeguarding of the health and safety of all participants who will be attending this in-person meeting. Pray for fruitful discussions as global leaders cooperate, collaborate and partner each other to address pressing global issues.

Pray for our Singapore government to be divinely led in the gradual re-opening of our economy; that Phase 3 will be well timed; for continued vigilance by all Singapore residents in the compliance of safe management measures, especially during this holiday season.

DIOCESE

Marine Parade Christian Centre

Pray for the smooth transition of leadership from Rev Joseph You to Canon Terry Wong. Pray for fresh envisioning, wisdom and strength for Canon Terry as he begins his new role in MPCC. Pray for good working partnerships with staff and ministry leaders and for meaningful relationships to be forged with all members of MPCC. Pray that members of MPCC will continue to grow strong in the Lord and MPCC will be a beacon of Christ's light and hope to the communities around her and beyond.

My Saviour's Church

Pray for a fruitful Christmas outreach (Christmas @ Home) on 19 Dec when members invite family and friends to their homes to build friendships and share Christ with them. Pray also for the Church Services to creatively minister to the masses onsite and via online platforms.

Pray for all who have been or will be confirmed at 3 different Services in the Cathedral; that they will continue to walk closely with the Lord, serve Him with their spiritual gifts and integrate well into the Cathedral family.

Please book your preferred date and time of Service; only worshippers who book may be admitted into the Services.

Worshippers can do this online at cathedral.org.sg/cws or phone 63376104. Bookings open at 1pm, a week before the day of the Service (eg. booking for a Sunday Service on 30 August will be open at 1pm on Sunday,23 August), and close at 1pm a day before the Service. For Services in Mandarin please call 63392435. Walkins will not be allowed entry.

PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR ENTRY & EXIT

If you are coming to the Cathedral on foot, use the MRT Gate (the pedestrian gate next to the Cathedral Café) for entry and exit.

If you are driving,

enter by the SRC Gate (the vehicular gate facing the Singapore Recreation Centre) and exit by the Padang Gate. Worshippers may park their vehicles in the allocated parking space.

Please arrive early, but not earlier than 30 minutes before the start of a Service.

Worshippers (and their vehicles) must leave the church premises not later than 30 minutes after the Service ends.

For weekday Services,

worshippers will enter the Nave by the North Transept Door and exit by the 2 doors leading to the North and South Transepts.

SAFE ENTRY

2 Safe Entry stations are located at the Drop Off Point and the Tent next to the Nave.

Safe Entry Check-in via TraceTogether Token or App only. SafeEntry check-ins by SingPass or QR Code will be discontinued immediately.

With effect from 6 Dec 2020, all entry to St Andrew's Cathedral compound must be done with the TraceTogether app or token. As an interim measure for the month of December, your NRIC card may be used, if you have not already obtained the TraceTogether token or apps.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES:

Masks

must be worn at all times, except when communicants are partaking of the bread and wine.

Mingling

Worshippers are reminded not to mingle before and after each Service, and to leave the church premises promptly after the end of the Service. The gates will be closed 30 minutes after the end of each Service.

Pilot Test to hold CWS for 250

St Andrew's Cathedral has been selected by MCCY to hold worship services for up to 250 worshippers. We will be making the following changes to comply with MCCY guidelines:

Initial trial for 150 worshippers

For the month of December, starting from 6 Dec 2020, the 11.30 am English Service and the 9.30 am Mandarin Service will be conducted for 150 worshippers – split into 3 clusters of 50 worshippers: Upper Nave, Lower Nave and South Transept Hall.

All other Congregational Worship Services will remain unchanged, in terms of size and venue.

CWS will be video-recorded

All Congregational Worship Services will be video-recorded. All worshippers and service personnel are required to wear masks and to comply with the authorities' Safe Management measures for religious organisations, including SafeEntry, temperature checks, attendance taking and safe distancing. There is to be no mingling before, during, or after Services.

Choice of the Cluster you will be seated in when you book for CWS

Worshippers may now choose the cluster they wish to be seated in when booking to come for the Service. Changes after booking will not be accepted.

Christmas Week and into 2021

We will be allowed to increase to a total of 250 worshippers, for the Christmas week Services (Lessons and Carols, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services) if the initial trial is successful. More information of the Christmas Week Services will be released soon.

More services at the CNS will be added from 2021.

PRIVATE WORSHIP

DAILY, FROM 10AM TO 4PM

Except on Mondays, Saturdays and Sundays, worshippers may enter the Nave for personal prayer, individually or in groups of not more than 5 each.

BOOKING A PRAYER SESSION

Each session is for 30 minutes, starting on the hour. Please phone 63376014 to book an appointment. Subject to availability, walk-ins may be permitted.

ENTRY INTO THE CATHEDRAL

All will enter the Cathedral premises by the MRT Gate (next to the Welcome Centre / Café). There will be no entry to vehicles; drivers are advised to park their cars in the carparks outside the church.





SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building have succumbed environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical

works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
