

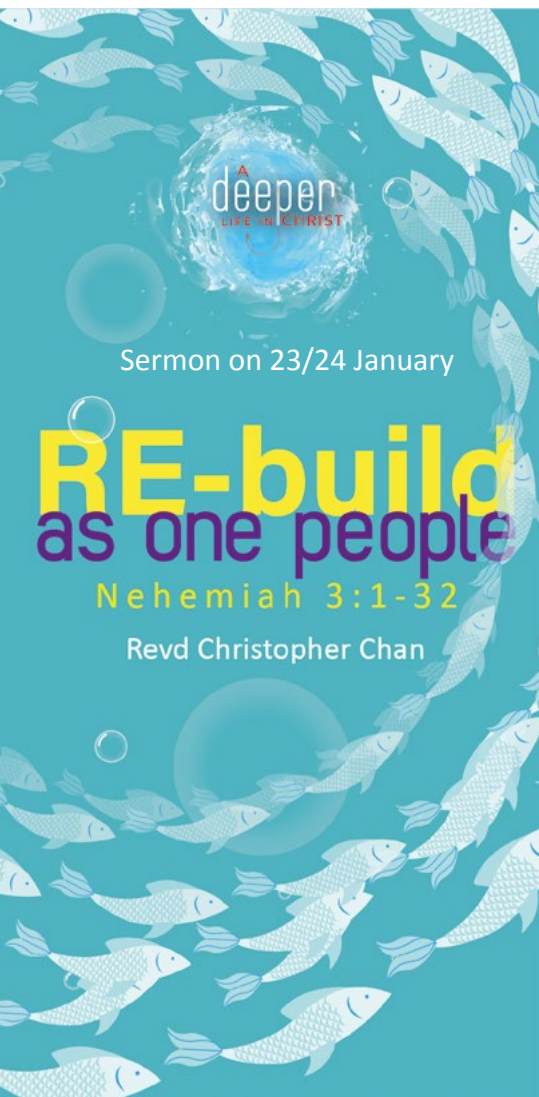

KEEPING THE CATHEDRAL SAFE FOR ALL

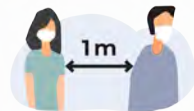
Checking in via TraceTogether Token or App only

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for political stability in Malaysia, that both the ruling and opposition parties will look beyond their differences and work together to combat COVID19 in the country. As the daily number of infections continue to spike, pray for the government to act swiftly and decisively with effective measures to reduce the rate of transmissions, safeguard the welfare of the people and support business continuity. Pray for the successful recruitment of 3,500 healthcare personnel and for more hospital facilities with increased capacities to cope with the record number of cases. Pray for the recovery of those who have been infected and for the protection of health care workers.

SINGAPORE

Thank God that our government has been making strenuous efforts to track and quarantine the number of imported COVID19 cases and keep local transmissions low. Pray that the government will continue to be proactive and vigilant as Singapore seeks to allow more large-scale events to safely resume. Pray for good planning and organisation of The Shangri-La Dialogue and World Economic Forum's Special Annual Meeting to be hosted by

Singapore this year; that these meetings will be carried out smoothly and safely, with beneficial outcomes to participating nations.

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
