

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

The World

Pray for Peru and its 33 million people where COVID has infected more than 1.1. million people and taken more than 40,000 lives. In Lima, the capital and largest city of Peru, hundreds of people are queuing overnight and for days to purchase oxygen for their loved ones who have been infected but have to be cared for at home as hospitals are short of beds. Pray for God's mercy to stop the spread of the killer virus and for the healing of the sick.

Pray also for India in the aftermath of a glacier that snapped, sending an avalanche of devastating flood waters downriver on 9 Feb, leaving at least 26 people and 165 people missing. Pray for families who lost their loved ones, for the missing to be found and for the government to take effective action to handle this incident.

SINGAPORE

Pray for a clear delivery of Budget 2021 by Deputy PM and Finance Minister Heng Swee Keat on 16 February; that the Budget will address concerns for sufficient government fiscal support to sustain economic recovery and for more resources to be channeled to vulnerable segments of our society as well as sectors hardest hit by the pandemic. Pray that businesses will receive the needed help to take advantage of new opportunities and to develop their capabilities, digitalize, invest into new technologies and to internationalize. Pray also for government agencies such as the Internal Security Department to remain vigilant to planned terror attacks on religious institutions by self- radicalized persons; that the people in Singapore will remain alert to extremist influences from online sources and take all necessary measures to prevent the propagation of extremist ideologies.

Pray that members of St Andrew's Community Chapel will grow in their personal relationship with God and in their self-discovery of God. Pray that they will also grow in personal engagement in ministry and in the personal discipling of others.

St Andrew's City Church

Pray that the staff and members of St Andrew's City Church will recapture afresh what it means to be a disciple and disciple maker of Jesus Christ. Pray for clear and inspiring preaching from the pulpit and for unity in all the sectors of the church, namely the staff, the Parochial Church Council, the leaders and members.

Lazarus Ministry

Thank God for the Cathedral's ministry to roughsleepers. We come alongside them, befriend them and when opportunities present themselves, aid them in tangible ways. They are people of worth and dignity, who are made in God's image. Pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to lead the ministry team as they maintain contact with 14 roughsleepers and enable the team to relate to them with empathy and compassion. Pray that the team will be able to befriend and love these our neighbours in fresh and engaging ways, loving them as we love ourselves, and in so doing,

point them towards Christ who alone can give us hope. Pray also for divine healing for a roughsleeper in Redhill who is suffering from a serious ailment.

and safe distancing. Please note that mingling is not allowed before, during, or after Services




PRIVATE WORSHIP (Change in venue)

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building have succumbed environmental wear and The Restoration tear. Works will involve re-plastering and painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical

works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
