

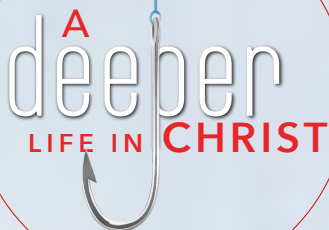

THE WORLD

Myanmar

Pray for creative solutions to tackle varied issues including youths at risk, national security and climate change. Pray that our health care system will continue to remain robust and ready to meet any future challenges.

KEEPING THE CATHEDRAL SAFE FOR ALL

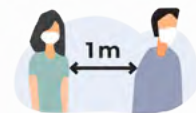
Checking in via TraceTogether Token or App only

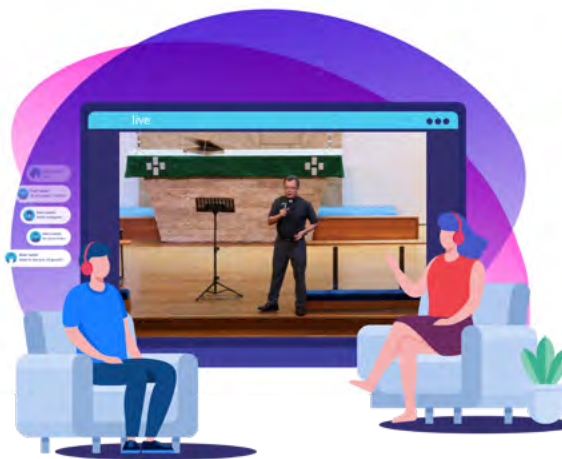
PRIVATE WORSHIP

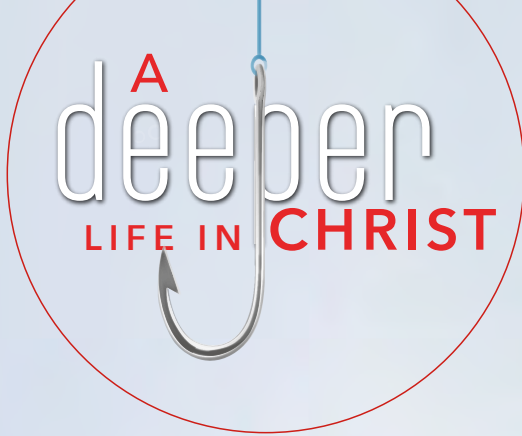

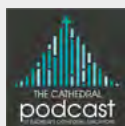

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
