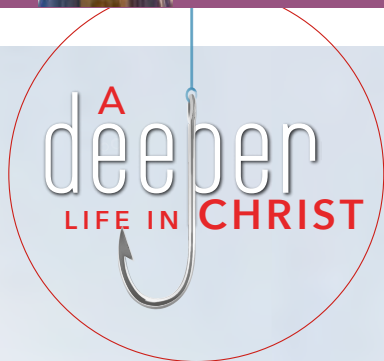

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Even as governments around the world seek to revive their country's ailing economies and safeguard their own interests, pray that world leaders will continue to strengthen their collaboration and cooperation with one another, in a collective effort to tackle common concerns such as climate change, the pandemic and security issues. Pray that they will put aside their personal agendas and differences to focus on what is needed, for the greater good of the global community. Pray that there will be a stop to the violence and killings in Myanmar and that law and order will be restored through peaceful negotiations.

SINGAPORE

Pray that our young people will not be conditioned by ideologies that divide religious groups or disrupt racial harmony; that their minds will be shielded from negative influences, especially from internet sources and that they will be guided in the way of truth. Pray also that the public will remain vigilant to signs of radicalisation in the community so that there can be early intervention to avert serious consequences. Pray for the continued preservation of racial and religious harmony in Singapore.

KEEPING THE CATHEDRAL SAFE FOR ALL

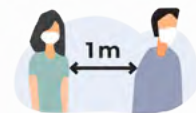
Checking in via TraceTogether Token or App only

All entry to St Andrew's Cathedral compound must be done with the TraceTogether app or token. Please ensure you have downloaded the app or brought along your token before you come for the service.



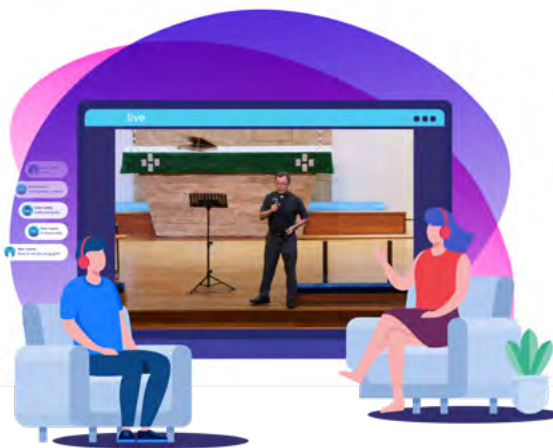
Observing Safe Distancing Measures

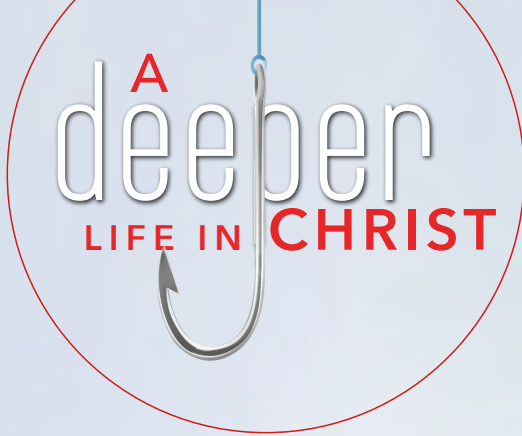

Notice is hereby given that the 2021 Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral will be held by way of ZOOM Webinar on Sunday, 25 April 2021 at 1pm (Singapore time).

Nominations

This AGM will elect the People's Warden and 12 members of the Parochial Church Council. Nomination forms are available on the Cathedral website or via this link <https://form.jotform.com/SACMembership/AGM2021NomForm>

According to the St Andrew's Cathedral Constitution, candidates for election to membership of the PCC shall be on the Electoral Roll of the parish and must be nominated by writing from one member and seconded by another to the Honorary Secretary. Proposers and Seconders are also required to be members on the Cathedral Electoral Roll.

Nomination forms are to be submitted not later than **12 noon on 6 April 2021**.

Electoral Roll

The Electoral Roll determines those who are eligible to either vote or be elected at the AGM onto the Parochial Church Council. Baptised members, who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, should be on the Electoral Roll.

The Electoral Roll (ER) determines those who are eligible to either vote or be elected at the AGM onto the Parochial Church Council.

All members are encouraged to check if they are on the ER. They can do so in the following manner:

1. Check online at <https://form.jotform.com/SACMembership/ER-enquiry>
2. Email to membership@cathedral.org.sg with your name as in NRIC, date of birth and mobile number

All new applications for ER must be submitted before **24 March 2021** to be eligible to vote at the coming AGM 2021.

All registration for AGM are to be submitted not later than **12 noon on 31 March 2021**.

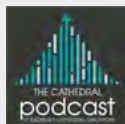

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.

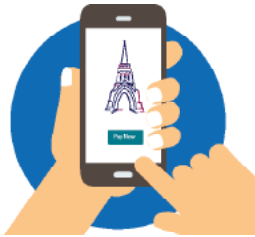
