

## PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

#### THE WORLD

The recent shooting in Atlanta which left 8 people dead, 6 of whom were Asian-American women, has raised concerns about the increased violence against Asians, during the global pandemic. According to UN spokesman Farhan Hag "The world has witnessed horrific deadly attacks, verbal and physical harassment, bullying schools, workplace discrimination, incitement to hatred in the media and on social media platforms, and incendiary language by those in positions of power". Pray that the leaders and people of the world, will stand together against hate crimes, racism and xenophobia and for all humankind to uphold the sanctity of life. Pray also for the Australian government to have wisdom in managing the widespread flooding in the state of New South Wales.

#### **SINGAPORE**

Pray that Malaysia and Singapore will be able to progressively restore cross border travel as both governments work out the operational details of a proposed mutual certification of vaccine certificates; that businesses and tourism can resume in a manner that will ensure the public

health and safety of the residents of both countries. Pray also for a strengthening of mutual cooperation to stimulate recovery from the effects of the global pandemic.





## SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building have succumbed environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical

works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
