# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

## THE WORLD

The recent shooting in Atlanta which left 8 people dead, 6 of whom were Asian-American women, has raised concerns about the increased violence against Asians, during the global pandemic. According to UN spokesman Farhan Haq “The world has witnessed horrific deadly attacks, verbal and physical harassment, bullying in schools, workplace discrimination, incitement to hatred in the media and on social media platforms, and incendiary language by those in positions of power”. Pray that the leaders and people of the world, will stand together against hate crimes, racism and xenophobia and for all humankind to uphold the sanctity of life. Pray also for the Australian government to have wisdom in managing the widespread flooding in the state of New South Wales.

## SINGAPORE

Pray that Malaysia and Singapore will be able to progressively restore cross border travel as both governments work out the operational details of a proposed mutual certification of vaccine certificates; that businesses and tourism can resume in a manner that will ensure the public

health and safety of the residents of both countries. Pray also for a strengthening of mutual cooperation to stimulate recovery from the effects of the global pandemic.

## DIOCESE

### Deanery of Vietnam

Pray for the Dean of Vietnam, Revd Jonathan Wong to know the Lord's mind as he oversees the work in the Deanery; for God's wisdom and protection over priests Nguyen Hong Chi and Jacob Vu Hong Thai and ABBA English Centre Principal Mrs. Rebecca Ngoc. Pray for the new church plant in Halong to be established and for members of the local churches who are feeling the economic effects of the pandemic, to experience God's provision and grace.

### 289 Fellowship of the Manger

Pray that God will bless the work of the 289 Fellowship of the Manger as they minister to the people from different villages in Batam. 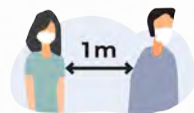
### Checking in via TraceTogether Token or App only



All entry to St Andrew's Cathedral compound must be done with the TraceTogether app or token. Please ensure you have downloaded the app or brought along your token before you come for the service.

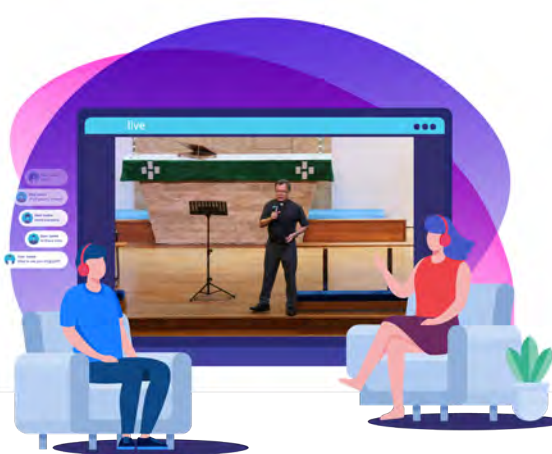
## Observing Safe Distancing Measures

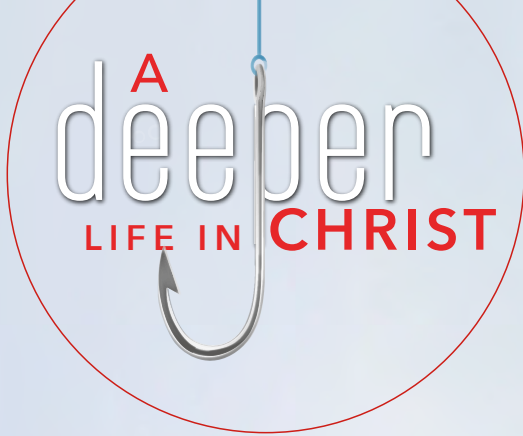

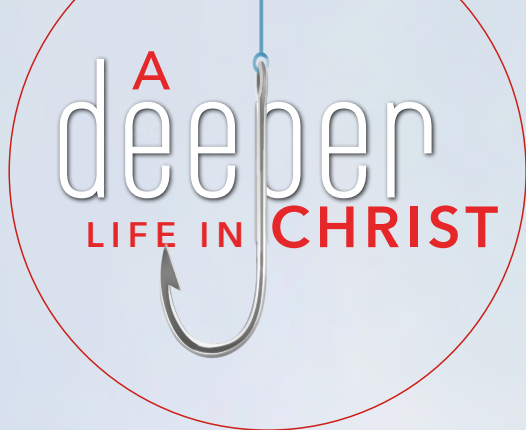

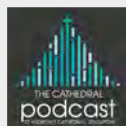
## Closure of the Listening Room from 1 Apr 2021

## SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
