

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

India has recorded more than 3 million new infections and 18,000 deaths this month. Pray for speedy containment measures to take effect in its worst-hit city New Delhi and in Maharashtra state (the epicentre of the recent surge); for timely replenishment of medical and oxygen supplies to meet the high demand in all hospitals and for the safety of all healthcare workers.

Coordinator that God will grant them divine wisdom and guidance as they oversee the large mission field in Nepal with 97 congregations, 1 kindergarten and 1 training centre. Pray also for political stability in this nation, for God's protection over the people against COVID-19 infections and for God's providence as the gospel advances in this land.

SINGAPORE

Thank God for our government's continued vigilance in updating travel measures for those entering Singapore, especially from countries with high COVID infections. Pray that the number of imported COVID cases will be effectively tracked and contained. Pray also that the low number of local transmissions will not result in complacency but that all Singapore residents will exercise due diligence in ensuring safe management measures are observed at all times.

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022



This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's building historic have succumbed environmental wear and The Restoration tear. Works will involve re-plastering and painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works. metal works, electrical

works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
