# **WORLD**

#### Iraq

Iraq's Christian community is one of the oldest in the world but has dwindled by about 83% in the last 15 years and Christians continue to fear for their safety and wonder if peace will last. Nevertheless, in areas where insurgents have been largely defeated, Christians are beginning to return. Pray for God's provision, hope, courage and the will to rebuild a completely destroyed homeland.

Pray that Iraq and all her people will enjoy a time of rest, rebuilding and relative political stability. Pray for healing from trauma and for accessible medical support and aid. Pray for schools starting in liberated regions like the Nineveh Plains. Pray that God will provide these schools with infrastructure, resources, and stability and that the children will be able to quickly enter into a routine that provides a sense of security and hope.

# **SINGAPORE**

Pray for divine guidance as the government leaders of Singapore and China continue to work towards advancing bilateral cooperation between our two countries. Pray also for God's wisdom to deepen such cooperation in many more areas, through the Joint Council for Bilateral Cooperation and other platforms.

Pray that the gospel seed which has been planted in the hearts of many, in Singapore and overseas, through the Celebration of Hope rallies, will continue to grow and bring forth much fruit. Pray that the witness of the Church will increase as the flame of evangelistic fervour continues to burn in the heart of every Christian.

# 289 FELLOWSHIP OF THE MANGER Mission Trip to Batam, Indonesia




# INFANT BAPTISM FOR 8.00 & 11.15 SERVICE MEMBERS - 4th AUGUST
