#### PASTORAL NOTE FROM THE BISHOP:

## **GIVE HIM A HUNDRED** & DIOCESAN MISSIONS MONTH

ear Vicars & PiCs, Greetings in the name of our precious Lord! As we prepare our members for the season of Advent, to celebrate the birth of Christ and to anticipate His return, I want to invite you to participate in our responsibility over the six deanery countries — Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Nepal, Thailand and Vietnam.

Our Diocese has the privilege and responsibility of joining the mission task of reaching out to more than 470 million people, by planting Anglican churches and engaging in Christian good works in these countries. It is a daunting task that requires all 27 parishes in Singapore to put our hands, hearts and mind together.

#### **FAITH TARGET: S\$1M for our DEANERIES**

Firstly, I would like to challenge all our members to raise a total sum of S\$1million through Give Him a Hundred 2019. This will be a free-will offering, over and above your tithes. We are encouraging young and old, schooling or working, to give one hundred units of any denomination God places on vour heart. What you raise will serve to support the infrastructural projects in one of the deanery countries and go towards part of the 1.4 million annual operational budget required by the six deaneries (see the special GHH booklets, available at the

Welcome Centre and the tract racks at North and South Transepts).

Please promote GHH your congregations. If they have given through GHH in past years, they can consider increasing their donation. If they have never given through GHH before, they can make a good start this year.

#### STEPPED-UP PRAYER

Secondly, I would like to engage you and your parish to step-up prayers for our deanery countries. I would like to suggest that you include the deanery countries in your weekly intercession during the services from now to the end of year.

The mission office will send a deck of selected Power Point slides that was presented at Synod as part of the updates on deaneries, to facilitate your time of prayer at the services.

Over and on top of that, I would like to call us to press-in to pray for deanery countries where Christians are being persecuted for their faith — particularly Indonesia and Nepal. Pray especially for God's sovereign protection over our churches and workers.

As I conclude this pastoral note, I want to say that I have been tremendously blessed by your support and partnership in the fields that God has entrusted to us.

#### THE WORLD

#### Indonesia

Indonesia has 270 million people, 300 ethnic groups which speak 700 different languages. It is divided into 34 Provinces across 3 time zones. It lies in a geographically volatile area that is susceptible to earthquakes and tsunamis. Indiscriminate logging has also threatened the environment and the traditional lifestyles of many people. Pray for the government to take appropriate measures to stop the exploitation of the forests and to minimise the loss of life in the event of future earthquakes and tsunamis. Thank God for the many ministry opportunities our Deanery has been given to bless this nation, especially through the building of schools. Pray for the provision of English teachers, church planters and lecturers, to meet the growing needs of the ministry.

#### **Hong Kong**

Pray that God will divinely intervene to stop the increasing flood of violence and senseless killing of innocent lives. Pray that those involved in perpetrating such wicked acts will be brought to justice and that God will restore peace to this broken land.

#### **SINGAPORE**

#### **Artificial Intelligence**

Singapore plans to develop and use Artificial Intelligence (AI) to transform the economy and improve peoples' lives, as a start in five areas: transport & logistics, smart cities & estates, healthcare, education, safety & security. Thank God for a proactive government that is continually exploring new frontiers to better the lives of Singaporeans. Pray that God will grant divine wisdom to all who are involved in the development and use of AI, to harness the benefits of advanced technology, manage the risks whilst also ensuring that our workforce is equipped with the necessary competencies to thrive in an AI-driven economy.

#### **SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022**

This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. Its cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
