THE SUMMONING

"Summon for me the people so that I can tell them my words, that they may learn to fear me all of the days they are alive on the earth and so that they may teach their children."

DEUTERONOMY 4:10 (LEXHAM ENGLISH BIBLE)

ost Bible versions will use terms like "gather" or "assemble" for this verse. But somehow the word "summon" conveys a greater sense of urgency or obligation, a mandate that needs to be obeyed.

To equate our nation and existence with Old Testament parallels may seem audacious and self-serving. And indeed some nations (and kings and queens) have abused these ideas of divine calling to justify the idea of their supremacy over others.

It is, however, a Christian idea that a people or nation's calling and raison d'être for existence is divine in origin, not to stamp one's supremacy but to obligate one to serve the world. It is a self-consciousness that we are a people who were blessed with blessings that were not our own (i.e. 1 Chronicles 29:14b). And arising from this sense of humility and gratitude, we serve.

Therefore, we are summoned

- Out of our self-occupation to our sense of destiny to serve His wide purpose in time and space.
- To pause to "say grace" over the spread on our table as a nation (Psalm 23:5), whether in seasons of abundance or want.
- That we may gather and remember, for ourselves and those coming after us.
- To sing, for we are a people who have songs from our shared history and destiny.

This is why these milestone gatherings are always important, Sunday Worship,

Easter and Christmas Services and yes, *Bicentennials*. Surely, our 200 years of existence as a "founded" modern nation should be a moment for deep spiritual commemoration.

I have never quite fathomed why the bells had to be restored and enhanced in 2019. Yet the winds of the Spirit led us to do it and in a way, they have a *summoning* role to call us to worship. The coming Bicentennial Christmas Carol Service is a unique idea in itself, celebrating the event of the birth of the Christ and that of our nation in one breath. We are acknowledging the true Architect of our nation, "from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name." (Ephesians 3:15).

THE WORLD

Vietnam

Vietnam gained independence from France in 1954. This was followed by three decades of war until the reunification of the North and South under the Communist Party in 1975. One of the major challenges facing the country is the need to reform its economy. Pray for the government to have wisdom as they seek to address various economic issues, reduce poverty, create jobs and attract foreign investment. Pray also for our Anglican priests Revd Hong Chi and Revd Vu Hong Thai who are pastoring their congregations in Ho Chi Minh and Hanoi respectively: that they will lead God's people with courage, strength and faith; build His church and serve the people of Vietnam through language training and humanitarian outreach efforts.

SINGAPORE

Dengue

The number of dengue cases has increased more than five times from the same period last year. From the beginning of this year till 23 Nov, there were 14,658 dengue cases and 76 active dengue clusters. Pray that the National Environment Agency, the Inter-Agency Dengue Task Force, Town Councils and Singapore residents will step up efforts to prevent the breeding of Aedes mosquitoes and find effective solutions to eliminate the spread of dengue.

Celebrate Christmas In Singapore (CCIS - 16 to 23 Dec 2019)

CCIS comes to Orchard Road from 16-23 December. There will be performances, interactive activities, carols, floats, choirs and much more, presented by local and invited overseas guest artistes. Pray for good weather, excellent organisation and anointed performances that will bring the true message of Christmas to the crowds in Orchard Road and turn many to Christ.

DIOCESE

Chapel of the Resurrection

Pray for the Vicar Revd David Lee, staff and leadership team to be refreshed and filled with joy as they consecrate themselves to the Lord's service. Pray for the various Christmas Outreach events in Cambodia, Batam and Singapore to be effective platforms for sharing the gospel and bringing many to salvation in Christ. Pray especially for God's favour on "Joy to Potong Pasir" (COR's first jointly organised Christmas Carnival with the People's Association on 21 Dec). Pray that the estimated 2000 participants attending this event, will experience Christ in a very special way and be drawn to Him.

CATHEDRAL

Filipino Christmas Festival (15 Dec 2019)

Pray that the Lord will bless this massive outreach to the Filipino community; for great weather, a good turn-out of Filipinos from all over Singapore, who will fill the Cathedral grounds. Pray that they will be touched by the warm hospitality of the Filipino and Cathedral community; they will have a beautiful time of fellowship and their hearts will be receptive to the love of God.





SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022

This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. Its cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
