A WORD FOR THE WEEK

ast weekend, Pastor Grace Tan spoke Lon the importance of knowing God's Word: reading, digesting, applying and living it. Bishop Rennis spoke on the importance of small groups or Connect Groups, as we will call them here. Even as the Season of Epiphany concluded. we have a good number of carefully prepared and prayed-through sermons where the "Word in season" is heard. As we are in different Services, I encourage you to dig around and listen to them online whenever you can. You will be blessed. These sermons are also in line with our focus on personal discipleship for this year.

I am away this weekend for the Installation Service of the Rt Revd J Melter Tais of the Diocese of Sabah, as the new Archbishop of the Province of South East Asia at All Saints Cathedral, Kota Kinabalu. He takes over from Archbishop Ng Moon Hing, who is also the Bishop of West Malaysia. The Province of South East Asia contains four dioceses: West Malaysia, Sarawak, Sabah and Singapore.

Bishop Melter became the 6th Bishop of Sabah in 2015 and was the first native of Sabah to be installed. A father of four children, Melter Jiki Tais was ordained into the Anglican priesthood in 1993 and had served in various capacities in



many parts of Sabah, including Priest-in-Charge of St Margaret's Church in Keningau and St Peter's Church in Tenom, Rector of St. Mark's Church in Lahad Datu and St Luke's Mission District in Telupid. He is also a member of the Lambeth Design Group, planning the programme for Lambeth 2020.

Please pray for our new Archbishop as he leads the Province and her missionary work. There are difficult challenges in our Communion and as our Primate, he will also be making vital contributions in this area.

Revd Yessua, the Sub-Dean of All Saints Cathedral in Cairo (Egypt) will be spending two weeks at our Cathedral as an observer from the 1st to 14th of this month. Please welcome him warmly.

The **Coronavirus Crisis** has pretty much been the topic of many conversations throughout the Chinese New Year season. As a Cathedral, while we wait for updates and circulars from the Diocese, each of us can take some obvious responsibilities such as refraining from being at Services if we are ill and practising good hygiene. There are hand cleansers placed at strategic locations which we can make use of.

Meanwhile, we remember these words in **Psalm 91:1, 5-6**, which we can use to pray for ourselves and others:

"He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High

will abide in the shadow of the Almighty....

You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness.

nor the destruction that wastes at noonday."





THE WORLD

Pray for the World Health Organization as they seek to provide global leadership, to the containment of the novel coronavirus outbreak and to the provision of all necessary technical and operational support to prepare for and respond to this outbreak, especially in vulnerable countries. Pray for China as her government collaborates with WHO and partner countries, to investigate the epidemiology and evolution of this outbreak and measures to contain it. Michael Ryan, head of the WHO Health Emergencies Programme, told reporters in Geneva that "The whole world needs to take action." Pray that every country in the world will take the necessary steps to prevent and to stop the rapid spread of this virus.

SINGAPORE

Pray that our Minister for Health Gan Kim Yong and officials in his ministry, will be divinely guided as they prepare for various scenarios to manage the global outbreak of the novel coronavirus as it continues to evolve. Pray that every person living in Singapore will play our part by being socially responsible to prevent any possible spread of the virus in the community. Pray for God's protection upon our healthcare workers and for renewed strength as they work tirelessly to keep Singapore and those living in our city, safe.



FROM BISHOP RENNIS:

Thank you for your thoughts and prayers for our Diocese in the selection process of my successor, the 10th Bishop of Singapore (The Anglican Church).

It is my joy to let you know that Rev Canon Dr Titus Chung has been selected for the tasks of the office (1 Tim 3.1).



Among his many responsibilities, Canon Titus is presently the Priest-in-charge of the Cathedral Mandarin Congregation, the Convenor of Continuing Ministerial Education for clergy, an adjunct lecturer at Trinity Theological College and a member of our Senior Clergy Planning Team. His PhD is in Systematic Theology from the University of Edinburgh. He is married to Connie, a Music teacher, and they have two sons in their twenties.

The Provincial House of Bishop has appointed Canon Titus Chung as Bishop-designate with effect from 4 February 2020. His Consecration/Installation service as Diocesan Bishop is scheduled for 18 October 2020 (St Luke's Day). More details will follow.

Please remember him and his family in your prayers. Pray also for effective induction and handing over of responsibilities, as well as for our shared leadership of the Diocese till my 'Completion of Term' Thanksgiving Service on 30 August 2020 at 5 pm at St Andrew's Cathedral.





FAREWELL TO REVD PETER COOK

Revd Peter and Ineke will be returning to the UK after nearly 5 years in Singapore, and over 14 years serving in the Diocese in South East Asia. This is so they can spend more time with their children and grandchildren. Their last Sunday with us will be the 15th of March.

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT. 2020-2022

This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and



exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. Its cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.




