rom 15-18 June, more than 300 of us gathered in Holiday Villa, JB, for this year's church camp. Guided by Bishop Emeritus Dr Gordon Wong's insightful teaching on John 15:1-17, we reflected together on our camp theme, Abiding in the Love of Christ. Over 4 sessions, Bishop Gordon exhorted us on these key points: (1) Abiding in Christ, (2) Abiding in the Love of Christ, (3) Abiding in the Fruit of the Love of Christ, and (4) Abiding in the Love of Christ: Experiencing Joy. He urged us to grow in our love for Christ and for one another.

His reflection on Jesus's words in v. 7, "If you abide in me, and my words abide in you...", resonated with many of us. The second part of this statement can be understood as allowing the words of Jesus to "be at home in us", and this is a call to immerse ourselves in Scripture. This call, of course, was made to the SAC community at the beginning of the year. I hope that all of us have been progressing well with our Bible reading plans. If not, it's not too late to catch up!
