

The theme for this year was "Into the Deep", which is based on two passages: Matthew 14:22-33 (Jesus calling Peter to walk on water) and Ezekiel 47:1-12 (Living waters flowing from the Temple).

While seeking God for the camp theme, the camp committee noticed how frequently water imagery appeared as the various members were sharing their thoughts. We were deeply convicted that God intended to use this camp as a means of encouraging our young people to leave their comfort zones to go deeper into God's calling for them, bring living waters to those around them, and have faith in God to see them through. Incredibly, as the committee conducted a site recce of the school grounds, they noticed that the interior design and decorations featured a lot of marine motifs. They saw this as a confirmation of God's direction for this camp.

We enjoyed an exciting weekend filled with games (many were wet games, of course), challenges, fellowship, worship, and hearing the Word. We were also glad that our friends from Westside Anglican Church could join us for the camp!

Luke Zachary Ng from Scripture Union, our camp speaker, led an altar call on the final night of the camp. Amazingly, each and every young person responded! Staff Movement




