YOUTH MISSION TRIP

Following last year's eventful trip, 7 youths (19-25 year olds) signed up for this year's trip to Mae Sot, Thailand. We spent 7 days ministering to the Karen people, conducting a youth leadership camp for the youth leaders from the Anglican churches in the region, as well as various children and youth programmes for the different communities in Mae Sot, Mae Salit, and Mae La.

We had a great time building relationships with the youths there, and we're hoping that this could pave the way for a long-lasting partnership between the Cathedral and St. Stephen's Church, Mae Sot. Do continue to keep us in prayer as we discern how we can work together to build up the body of Christ.



YOUTH SUNDAY

YOUTH MINISTRY INTERNS

We thank God for Dafina and John, who came on board as our ministry interns from March to June/July. Besides serving in various capacities with the NextGen ministry (e.g., Sunday School, Metamorphosis, and the youth mission trip), they have also been actively involved in several other ministries in the Cathedral, such as CITY Community Services, helping out in the Welcome Centre, and serving at the Wednesday worship service, to name a few. Of course, it's not just all about work; spiritual formation is also a key component of this internship. Our interns participated in the Daily Offices and had weekly discipleship sessions with the pastoral team. It has been a really eventful time with them. Here is what they have to say about their internship experience:

I learnt what goes on behind the scenes in different ministries and got to be a part of the team planning an overseas mission trip. I also got to use my skills in organising to tidy up the Welcome Centre. On top of all this, I picked up skills in active listening and how to intentionally help others.
