Dear Friends,

Project Khmer H.O.P.E.(PKH) marked her 25th anniversary in 2025, and we thank God for his faithfulness and goodness towards the people and the work in Cambodia. We are deeply grateful for the tremendous support and continued partnership of each and every one of our PKH Friends who enabled us to continue the work in Cambodia over these years.

In this anniversary year, we celebrated with the community, God's goodness and His presence through the work of PKH in the province of Kampong Speu. Many stories were shared; young men and women who received care, education and encouragement at the PKH Centres, successfully graduated and found jobs in the hotel and service industries in the cities. Consequently, they were able to support their families in their hometowns and many who were married, started families of their own. Stories were also shared about those who progressed to become Managers, General Managers and CEOs. Some of these stories are captured in a specially-produced video to commemorate our 25th anniversary. The link to the video is here in this report.

PKH remains committed to helping the poor in Cambodia so they break out of the poverty cycle, and to share the hope and love of Christ. In 2025, 94 young men and women enrolled in vocational training at the PKH Chbarmon and Aoral Centres, 163 children were cared for at the PKH Trang Centre and 31 children attended the PKH English School. PKH also supported a third of the 42 children at risk under the Seeds of Hope Project, to provide a safe home for them at the Full Gospel Assembly Centre. We also rejoice with all who had come to faith in Christ during the year, including 8 who were baptised at the Anglican Church in Phnom Penh. May the Lord bless all of them.

January 2026 Update

For the new year of 2026, PKH's operational budget is USD300,000 (~SGD380,000).

We aim to provide these services free of charge to poor Cambodians:

- Vocational Training for 100 young men and women at Chbarmon and Aoral
- Before-after School care for 170 children at Trang
- English Tuition for 40 children at PKH English School
- Support for 14 children-at-risk at Seeds of Hope

We are also exploring the feasibility of starting a new vocational training course for Healthcare Assistants.

Thank you for journeying with us in prayer and for your continued support of the work at PKH. May you be encouraged as you witness, through pictures and video, the impact of your support in the lives of these young men and women, and children in the community.
