PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Let us seek the Lord as the world looks on with grief at the escalating conflicts in the Middle East. In the midst of falsehood, injustice, and the loss of innocent lives, pray that God, in His righteousness and mercy, will bring down what is unjust, frustrate what is evil, and restore peace to the nations. Remember that the Lord is righteous in all His ways and faithful in all He does. May He be a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble, and arise to defend the cause of the afflicted. For those who are broken-hearted and weary, may they take comfort that the Lord is near and that He understands our frailty. Pray that His people will find refuge in Him, and hold fast to the hope that He will make wars cease and bring peace to the earth.

SINGAPORE

We give thanks to the Lord for the peace and stability we enjoy in Singapore, recognising that it is His gracious hand that has sustained us. The Lord has been our help and our shield, and His blessing has rested upon our nation. Yet we confess that in times of comfort, our hearts can grow complacent. Pray that the Lord will search us and know our hearts, and turn us away from indifference, that we may not ignore those who are in need or choose convenience over compassion. Ask that Singapore may continue to be a place marked by hope and light. May the Lord make us glad by His presence, and let His people be a fragrance of His love in this city. May our nation flourish under His care, and be a witness of His goodness and grace to the world.

DIOCESE

Pray that the Lord will bless the Diocese-wide conference (called the Anglican Learning Festival) being planned by St Peter's Hall for Sep 2026, with high participation rates and quality of sessions. Pray that the Theological Education Board (TEB) will have wisdom to increase the rate at which new clergy are ordained for our Diocese to address the looming clergy shortage when the current clergy retire. Pray that as the new 3-year session of Synod commences in May 2026, the TEB might have the right mix of people (clergy and laity) stepping forward to serve and provide oversight for the ministry of St Peter's Hall.

CATHEDRAL

As we enter the final week before Good Friday and Easter, pray that we will devote ourselves to quiet reflection, preparing our hearts to journey with Christ once more to the cross at Golgotha. May our hearts be stirred afresh with gratitude to our loving God and Father, who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us, that we might be redeemed and receive eternal life in Him. Pray that our faith will be renewed and lifted, and that we may rise to be a people after His own heart, living out our calling as salt and light to the world and bringing hope to a suffering world. We also remember those who will join us as visitors during the Easter services. Pray that they will receive a warm welcome in our Cathedral, and that as they gather with us, they may encounter God's presence and come to know His love.

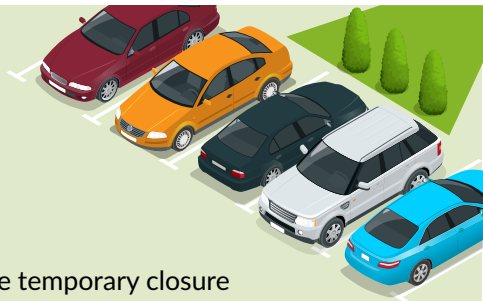

Notice is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral will be held on 19 Apr 2026 (Sunday) at 2pm at the Cathedral New Sanctuary (CNS).

NOMINATIONS

This AGM will elect the People's Warden, up to 12 lay representatives to be members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC), and 4 Synod representatives. Nominations forms are available at the Cathedral website or via this link: <https://form.jotform.com/SACMembership/AGM2026-PCC-Nomination-Form>.

According to the Constitution of St Andrew's Cathedral, candidates for election to the PCC shall be on the Cathedral Electoral Roll and must be nominated in writing by one member and seconded by another to the Honorary Secretary. Proposers and Seconders must be members on the Cathedral Electoral Roll.

Nomination forms must be submitted before 2pm on 29 March 2026 (Sunday).

ELECTORAL ROLL

The Electoral Roll (ER) determines those who are eligible to either vote or be elected at the AGM onto the Parochial Church Council. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the Electoral Roll.

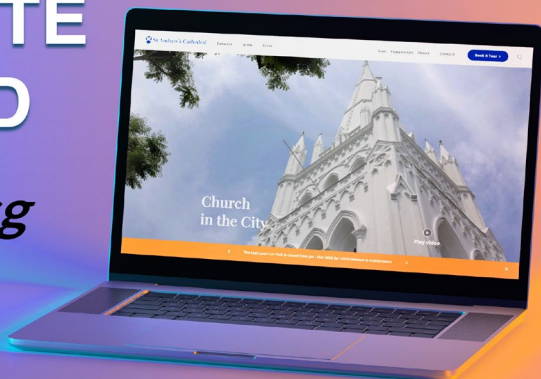

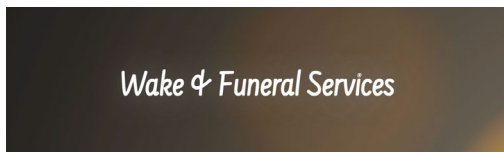

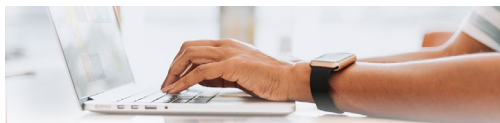
