PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Pray for the elderly in Singapore who must fend for themselves and who have no family or friends to rely on. Ask that they may be sustained through God's grace and loving provision. Pray also for those who do not yet know the salvation of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ask that God will open doors for the gospel to be shared with them, and that compassionate care will be extended to support them in their daily lives. Pray that they may experience God's peace and open their hearts to Him.

DIOCESE

For Church of Our Saviour, thank God for the many who received Christ, during their Good Friday and Easter weekend Services. Pray for

good follow up on these new disciples. Pray also for the smooth planning and preparation for their upcoming AGM, Youth and Children Evangelistic Outreaches, Church Camp and 70th Anniversary Dinner on 31 May 2026.

For Light of Christ Church Woodlands, thank God for the increase in student intake for their tuition programme. Pray for church leaders and members to be ready to minister to families living in the neighbourhood. Pray also for manpower and financial resources for the chaplaincy work to students of Christ Church Secondary school and for fruitful community outreaches, especially to seniors who are involved in activities organised by the Anglican Active-Aging Center in Woodlands.

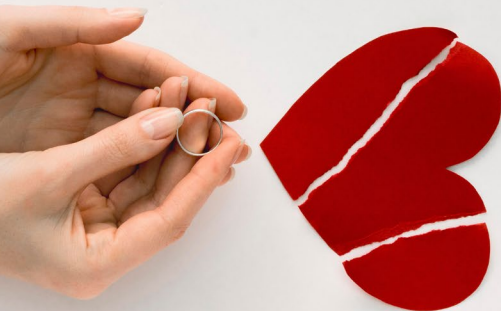

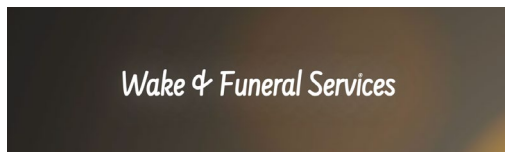

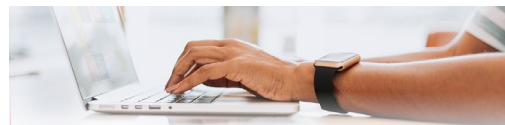
