SINGAPORE

Pray for President Tharman Shanmugaratnam, Prime Minister Lawrence Wong, and all who serve in government and the civil service as they lead the nation and uphold the work of public service. Ask that the Lord will grant them wisdom, integrity, and diligence in their responsibilities. We give thanks for the Lord's faithful watch over Singapore and commit our nation into His loving care. In a time when conflicts continue in many parts of the world, we are grateful for the peace and stability we continue to enjoy. Let us not take these blessings for granted, but remain watchful and live each day with a sense of purpose. May the Lord guard our hearts from complacency and help us to use well the opportunities He has given to us. Ask that He will shape us into a people who are mindful of others, ready to serve, and a blessing wherever we are.

For St James Church, we thank God for the many people who heard the gospel at their recent Easter evangelistic service. Pray that the seed of the gospel, and their experience of the warmth of Christian community, continue to stir in their hearts. 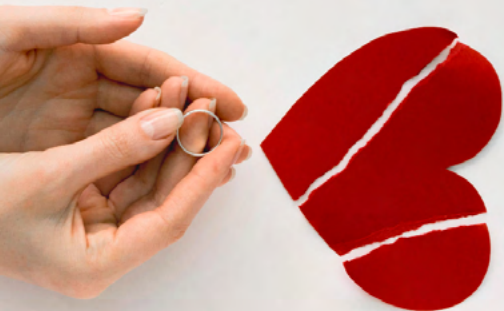

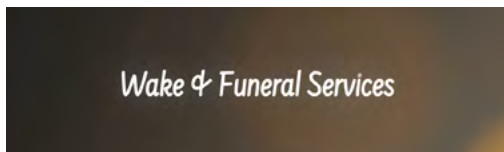

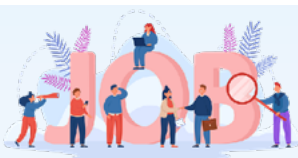
