PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Pray for Japan as it continues to experience frequent earthquakes. Ask that the Lord, in His mercy, will restrain further destruction, protect lives, and spare communities from harm, including the threat of tsunamis. Pray for those who monitor and study these natural events, that they may be given wisdom, insight, and accuracy in their forecasting so that timely warnings can be given and lives preserved.

Remember also the people of Japan, asking for the Lord's blessing upon the nation. Pray especially for the Christian community, that they may grow in faith and courage and bear faithful witness. Ask that hearts may be open to the gospel and that many may come to know Christ.

SINGAPORE

Pray for the Lord's guidance as Singapore embarks on a multi-year study of the south-west coastline and the challenges posed by rising sea levels. Ask that the teams, engineers, and consultants involved will be granted wisdom and foresight as they assess and develop effective protection measures. Pray for sound planning and capable leadership in this work so that the nation may be well prepared for the future and communities safeguarded.

DIOCESE

Pray for the Archbishop of the Province of the Anglican Church in South East Asia & Bishop of the Diocese of Singapore, the Most Revd Dr Titus Chung, Bishop of the Diocese of Sabah Rt Revd Datuk Melter Tais, Bishop of the Diocese of Kuching, Rt Revd Datuk Danald Jute and Bishop

of the Diocese of West Malaysia, Rt Revd Dr Stephen Soe Chee Cheng. Pray that God will grant them His vision, wisdom and strength to lead and shepherd the Anglican Church in the Province. Pray that the work of the Province will continue to grow and flourish under God's mighty hand, as His people unite in heart, mind and spirit, to advance His Kingdom and to make disciples of all nations.

CATHEDRAL

Pray for the 27 choir members travelling to Thailand from 1-4 May, to sing and celebrate with the people of Lat Krabang Anglican Church, as they consecrate their new building extension, and Christ Church Bangkok, as they hold their confirmation service. We ask that You keep their eyes on Jesus and tune their hearts to sing Your praise. We also pray for Your good hand to be upon them, protecting them and their families, granting them journey mercies, and to provide them with good musical and AV equipment. May the Thai church be blessed and encouraged through the music they share.

Pray also for the Adopt a Block in the Community (ABC) Ministry event on 16 May, as it reaches out to residents through the Healthy 123 Day initiative to promote healthy living. Ask that there will be a good response from volunteers, and that the event will be carried out with joy and care. Most of all, pray that the love of Christ will be made known through every interaction, and that the presence and service of our members will bring encouragement and uplift the spirits of those who attend.

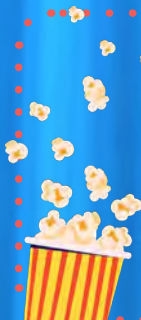

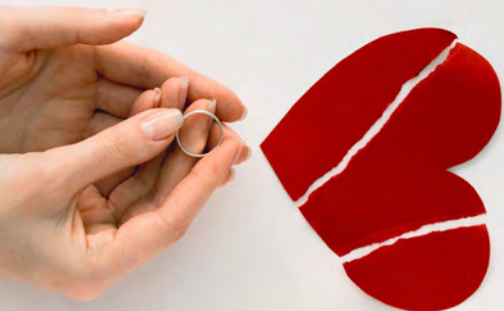

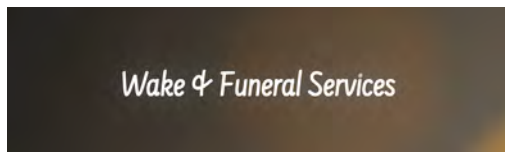
