THE VICAR WRITES

REV. CHRISTOPHER CHAN



Praise God for a smooth Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 19 April! We thank all who took part, and continue to urge all members to participate in this important meeting as an expression of our commitment to SAC's life and ministry. The AGM is an opportunity to acknowledge God's favour upon us, and by His grace we have had much good news to share over the past few years.

The AGM is also when the Parochial Church Council (PCC) is elected. Your involvement in this process is important, even when we do not have more candidates than vacancies! Your presence and support at the AGM mean a lot to the PCC members, and I urge all of us to pray for these brothers and sisters who have offered themselves to serve as your representatives. May the Lord grant them wisdom to fulfil their duties in accordance with His will!

One thing that we're extremely grateful for this year is the notable increase in

attendance at Prayer & Praise, our corporate prayer meeting. We haven't done a precise count of attendees, but we've probably had around 300 persons or more at each meeting this year. This has been highly encouraging, and this prayer momentum must be sustained!

However, 300 is still merely a fraction of our service attendance. We're praying that more members will catch the fire of prayer. If you've not been coming for the prayer meeting, I implore you to make it a priority. If there's a lack of desire in your heart, confess that to God and ask Him to ignite something in you. If you've been coming, please continue to do so, and always try to bring others with you—especially those who have not made it a part of their routine.

Why all this emphasis on prayer? Because in prayer we cast aside any illusions of self-sufficiency and express our reliance on God. I believe that God is doing something significant in SAC, and I'm not alone. We've seen glimpses of this, but, as the saying goes, "We ain't seen nothing yet!" The question is not whether God has good things in store for us, but whether we truly desire to receive them. They must be received in a posture of prayer. So, let us step up our prayer life both privately and corporately. Let us seek the Lord for a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in our church. May He graciously answer our prayers!



PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Pray for Thailand as the country faces a period of intense heat, with temperatures reaching levels that place many at risk. Ask that the Lord, in His mercy, will bring relief to the land, temper the heat, and provide rain to cool the earth and sustain the crops. Pray for the people as they endure these difficult conditions, that they may be protected from harm and find shelter from the heat. Remember especially the elderly, young children, and those who are most vulnerable, asking that they may be kept safe and cared for. Pray also for the Church in Thailand as it reaches out to those in need. May the love of Christ be made known through acts of kindness and service, and may the Lord's grace shine even in the midst of these challenging circumstances.

SINGAPORE

Let us pray for Singapore in light of the concerns raised by our Prime Minister, Lawrence Wong, especially for workers and families facing ongoing economic pressures. Ask that the Lord will grant wisdom to our leaders as they respond to challenges such as the rising cost of living and the uncertainties of the times. We give thanks for the peace and order that we continue to enjoy in Singapore, and for a government that seeks to care for its people. Pray that we will not take these blessings for

granted, but remain a people who are watchful, grateful, and mindful of one another.

May our nation continue to be marked by harmony and resilience. May Singapore be a place we cherish and steward well, and a home where all may find security and hope.

For the Church of the Good Shepherd, pray that members will be firmly rooted in the Word of God, stay close to the Lord and reflect His love to the community around them. Pray that their hearts will be re-ignited with passion for evangelism and missions. Pray that the members, both the young and the old, will be united in their worship of God and that the Lord will provide more labourers for His harvest field.
