# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



## THE WORLD

Pray for the children in the Gaza Strip who continue to suffer amidst conflict and displacement. Ask that the Lord, in His mercy, would provide for their daily needs, especially food, medical care, and shelter. Pray particularly for children weakened by hunger and malnutrition, that timely aid and medical supplies may reach them. Remember especially those who have lost parents and family members. May the Lord draw near to them with His comfort and protection and be Father to the fatherless. Pray also for the medical teams and volunteers serving on the ground, that the Lord would grant them safety and strength as they care for the injured.

## SINGAPORE

Pray for the elderly in our nation, especially those who live alone or face the challenges of ageing without strong family support. Ask the Lord to watch over them daily, giving strength, comfort, and peace, as well as surrounding them with caring neighbours, friends, and communities. Remember especially those who do not yet know the Lord. Pray that they would encounter His love through the kindness of Christians, and come to know the hope, comfort, and assurance found in Him.

## DIOCESE

Pray for unity and consolidation of the present work in the Deanery of Indonesia, for the discipleship of members to be deepened and

for the equipping of church leaders. Pray for the new Acting Dean, Revd Stevanus Mudjianto, and indigenous cluster leaders to have the vision and alignment to take the Deanery to the next season of growth. Pray also for God's direction to be discerned as our Archbishop Titus Chung meets the cluster leaders in June.

## CATHEDRAL

Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who will be confirmed at the 4.30pm Service on this Pentecost Sunday, that they will continue to grow strong in faith and in intimacy with the Lord, be rooted in the Word and empowered by the Holy Spirit to live for Christ and glorify His Name!

Pray also for members of our congregation who are sick in body, mind, and spirit. Ask the Lord to pour out His Holy Spirit afresh upon them, that they would be gently held in God's presence and filled with the comfort of the Holy Spirit. Pray also for those among us walking through difficult seasons: those grieving the loss of loved ones, those struggling with unemployment or financial strain, and those facing broken marriages and strained relationships. Ask the Holy Spirit to be their Comforter and strength, carrying them through every dark day with God's sustaining grace. Pray that every anxious heart would be quieted, and that they would be drawn closer to the Lord in trust and hope, learning to walk daily in step with the Holy Spirit and rest in His care.
