PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Pray for those affected by the recent coal mine explosion in Shanxi Province, China, which claimed many lives and left numerous others injured. Remember especially the families who have lost loved ones. Ask the Lord to draw near to them in their grief, comforting them with His peace and strengthening them as they cope with the shock and trauma of this tragedy. Pray also for those who were injured, that they would receive timely medical treatment and care. Ask the Lord to grant wisdom to the medical teams caring for them, and pray for healing, recovery, and hope for all who have been affected by this disaster.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our nation in light of the recent rise in traffic accidents and fatalities. Ask the Lord to deepen in all road users a greater respect for the value of life and a spirit of care for one another. Pray that motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians would act with patience, attentiveness, and consideration, recognising their shared responsibility for the safety and well-being of others. Pray also for school children and youths who have begun their June holidays. Ask that this break would provide rest and refreshment after a busy school term. Remember also families who are travelling during this period, that the Lord would grant them journey mercies, keep them safe from harm, and bless them with meaningful times together.

DIOCESE

For our Singapore Anglican Community Services and St Andrew's Mission Hospital, pray that through the holistic care provided, the sick, the elderly with frailty and dementia, as well as persons with autism spectrum disorder, or psychiatric disabilities, families in crisis, and the migrant workers may experience the love of Christ and be touched by His healing and hope.

Pray for the boards, management committees, and senior management, that their decisions and strategies may be granted God's wisdom, foresight, and favour and reflect the love of Christ and position SAMH-SACS to be a light in society, bringing relief and enrichment to those in need.

Pray for the staff and volunteers, that they may be blessed with good health, inspiration, and joy as they minister to the physical, mental, social, and special needs of the underserved, and their service is a reflection of Christ's love and compassion.

Pray for generous donations from churches, corporate partners, and individual donors, that God will move the hearts of many to support the chaplaincy work in SAMH-SACS and enable the continuation and expansion of holistic care to the disadvantaged.

Pray for the Chaplaincy Teams—chaplains, volunteers, and befrienders – as they provide spiritual support and pastoral care. May they be instruments of God's peace and love, bringing light and comfort to those they serve.

Pray for our choir members and Choir Director, Lim Chin Kai. Give thanks to the Lord for their faithful service and for the gifts and talents they offer each week, enriching our worship and helping the congregation lift their hearts in praise to God. Give thanks also for the new choir members who have recently stepped forward to serve. Pray that the choir would grow in unity, fellowship, and a shared desire to glorify the Lord. Ask that their hearts would be continually renewed with joy as they serve, and that through their ministry, many would be drawn into deeper worship and devotion to Christ.

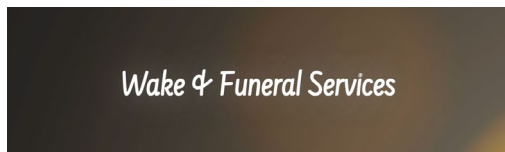

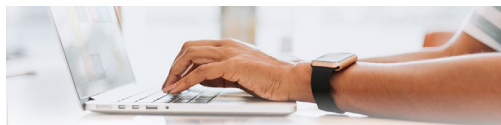

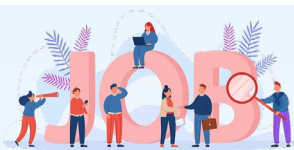
