In July we celebrate Youth Month, and I'd like to take this opportunity to underscore the importance of our young people in SAC. Many of them serve actively in ministry and contribute significantly to our community. Even in their young age, they are setting an example for others in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity (cf. 1 Timothy 4:12). Thank God for our youth!

It's no secret that bringing together the young and the old can be challenging, because they often have different perspectives and preferences. But the biblical vision of community is multigenerational, and God has ordained that different generations should make the journey of discipleship side by side. As the Rule of St Benedict impresses upon us, the young and the old should live and learn together.

In a 2023 FOPx survey, youth leaders in Singapore churches listed "spiritual guidance from experienced mentors" as the primary input they wished to receive from the wider church body. In The Generations Project, Ho Wei-Hao and Tan Soo-Inn note that these mentors should not function as experts who have all the right answers, but rather as loving guides who will come alongside the youth in a warm and

supportive relationship, and who are willing to be open and vulnerable about their own struggles and failures. Where older Christians are willing to serve the youth in this manner, the entire community will benefit!

As a church, we must make room for different generations to share life and grow together. Older members should prayerfully consider whom they could offer to mentor and journey with. Our young people might be more open to this than we think! Younger members should seek the Lord's guidance regarding whom to approach as a potential mentor. May He lead us to the right "match"!

If we're not interacting meaningfully with anyone in church who's from a different generation, then something is missing in our experience of spiritual community. There's so much we can gain as we learn from one another in both spiritual and practical ways. Not that this is something to be achieved through mere human effort. We need to receive the ministry of the Holy Spirit, collectively submitting ourselves to Him and allowing Him to transform our community life. May the Lord bless us richly as we, across different generations, intentionally journey together as disciples of Jesus Christ!

THE WORLD

Pray for the victims of the earthquake in Venezuela. Ask the Lord to surround those who are injured with His healing hands, bringing restoration and wholeness to their bodies. For the families grieving the loss of loved ones, pray that God's peace will be their comfort. Pray also for the international agencies working to bring aid to those affected by the earthquake. May the Lord grant them swift access to the hardest-hit communities, so they can deliver life-saving medical supplies, food, water, and essential support to those in need.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our children and young people as they return to school for a new term. May the Lord bless them with healthy bodies, eager minds, and joyful hearts, ready to learn and grow. Pray for God's protection over our schools, teachers, and families, and that His grace and favour would rest upon them in the months ahead.

DIOCESE

For All Saints' Church, pray for godly men and women to rise up to positions of leadership so that the baton may be passed on from an older to a younger generation. Pray for a strong partnership between the church and Anglican High School, that the chaplaincy ministry in this school will bear much fruit among the students. Pray also that the church will continue to be a bright and a vibrant witness to residents living in the neighbouring Bedok community.

For Chapel of Christ the Redeemer, pray that new lay leaders and full-time workers will hear the call to serve in the English and the Chinese congregations. Pray for more volunteers to join the chaplaincy ministry in St Hilda's Primary & Secondary Schools. For the Chinese Congregation, pray for renewed passion as they continue with their work; for the outreach work in the Senior Care Centre (Tampines 117) and the New Immigrants Ministry, to flourish under God's mighty hand.

Lift up in prayer our missionaries: Susan Goh and Joyce Carino, who are serving with PKH in Cambodia; Sok Chin Koabike and her family serving in Togo, West Africa; and Heidi Li serving in West Timor. As we remember them before the Lord, may they also be encouraged by the knowledge that they are lovingly remembered and faithfully upheld in prayer by their church family back home. Pray that the Lord would watch over them and provide for their every need, granting them safety, strength, and encouragement in their ministries. Ask God to renew and inspire their hearts each day, empowering them to continue His good work with joy and perseverance. May the seeds they sow in faith take root and flourish, bearing abundant fruit for His kingdom and bringing glory to His name.

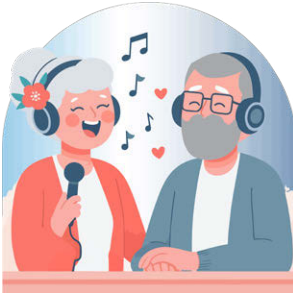

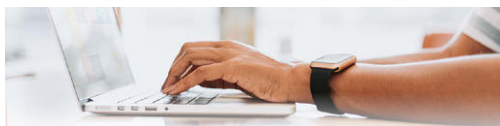
