May the Church be a faithful witness to His unchanging truth, love, and hope, helping many to look beyond what technology can offer and find their ultimate hope and security in the Lord.

SINGAPORE

Pray for Singapore as we prepare to celebrate our 61st National Day. Give thanks to God for His faithfulness in granting our nation peace, stability, and harmony through the years. Ask the Lord to keep us humble in our success, remembering that every good and perfect gift comes from Him. Pray also for the Church in Singapore, that we may be renewed in God's calling to be His faithful witnesses. May He fill us afresh with His Spirit, that our lives may bear the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22–23). May we redeem the time and faithfully proclaim the gospel, serve our communities with Christ's compassion, and raise high the name of Jesus, so that many may come to know Him as Lord and Saviour.

For St Matthew's Church, pray for the Vicar Revd Aaron Cheng, clergy and staff, to have divine

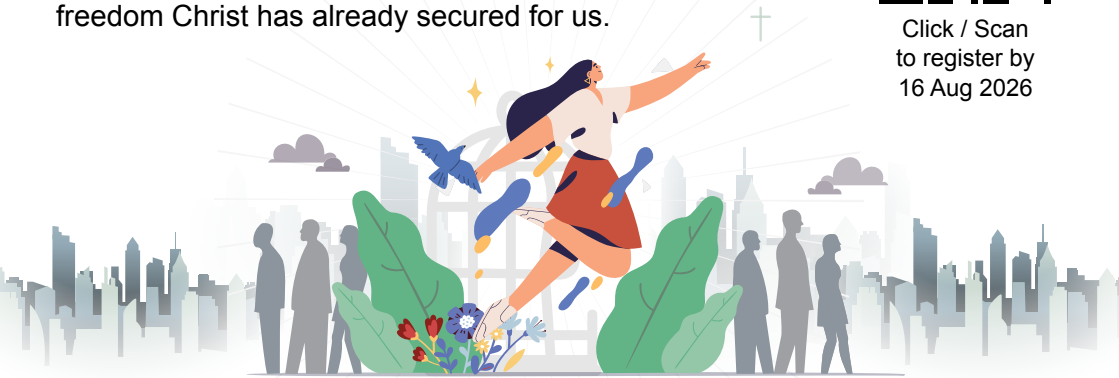

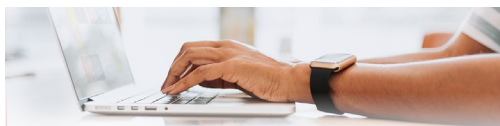
