PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

Pray for the nations affected by prolonged conflict and war, especially the Middle East following the collapse of the ceasefire, Ukraine, where the war with Russia continues with no clear end in sight, and Myanmar, where a protracted civil war continues to bring widespread suffering. Remember before the Lord the millions of people whose lives have been disrupted by violence, displacement, loss, and uncertainty. Pray for God's mercy to bring an end to these conflicts, to restore peace and order, and to grant protection, provision, and hope to those enduring hardship. Pray also for the governments and leaders involved, that they will exercise wisdom and restraint in the decisions they make. Ask that the Lord would turn their hearts towards righteousness and justice so that they may seek the welfare of their people and pursue paths that lead to lasting peace.

SINGAPORE

Pray for those serving in Singapore's uniformed services, especially the Police Force, Civil Defence Force and Armed Forces, who work tirelessly to safeguard our nation's security, peace and well-being. Remember those who serve on the front lines, often in demanding and hazardous situations, responding to emergencies and protecting lives. Pray for the leaders of these organisations, that God will grant them wisdom, integrity and courage as they lead, inspiring those under their charge to carry out their responsibilities faithfully. Pray also for God's protection over every officer and serviceman

as they discharge their duties, and for strength, resilience and encouragement for them and their families.

DIOCESE

For the Deanery of Cambodia, pray for the 29 brothers and sisters in Christ who will be confirmed on 9th Aug to be strengthened by the Holy Spirit, to walk in faith and to serve. Pray for Revd Wenbin and his team as they start a new Chinese service in Sen Sok and for God to draw in the people. Pray for the Cambodian youths that come for the monthly prayer fellowship to encounter God in a real and tangible way.

CATHEDRAL

Pray for our Lay Readers as they faithfully serve the Cathedral in worship, pastoral care, and various ministries. Give thanks for their willingness to answer God's call to serve His people and to support the life and witness of the Church. Pray that each Lay Reader will continue to grow in a close and abiding walk with the Lord, drawing daily upon His strength, wisdom, and grace. May they serve with humility, faithfulness, and a Christ-like heart, seeking to be the hands and feet of our Lord in all that they do. As they minister to the congregation and to all whom God places in their path, may His love, peace, and grace be evident through their lives, bringing encouragement, hope, and blessing to many.

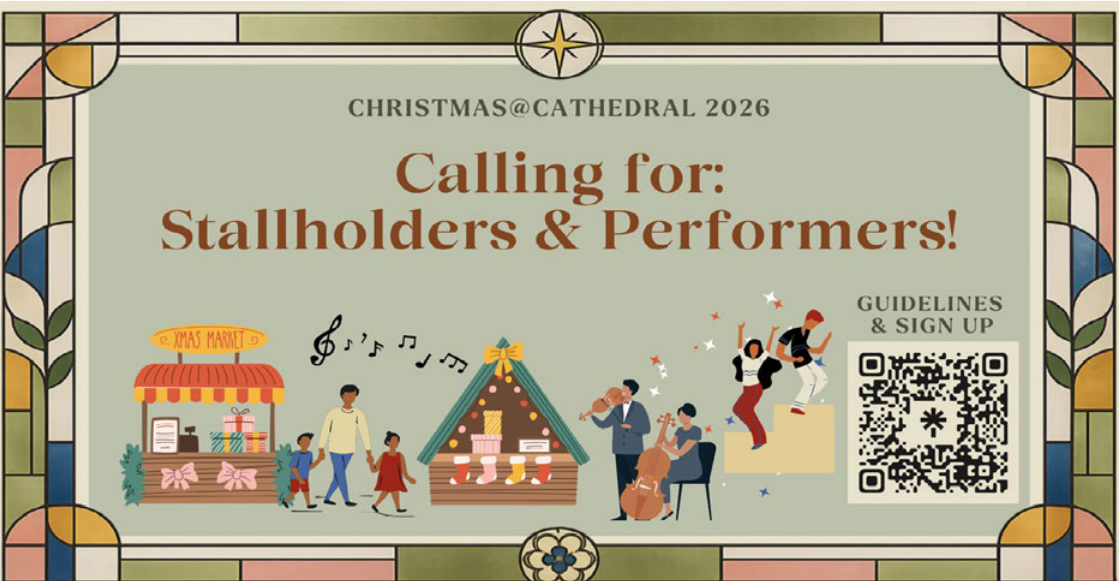

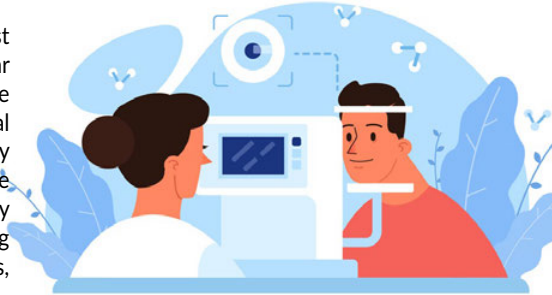
Caring for the Eyes God Has Given Us

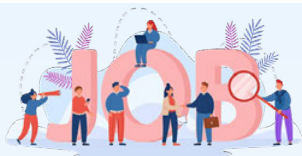
