THE WORLD

Pray for Pakistan following the recent suicide bombing in the Swat Valley that claimed many lives and left others injured. Remember the families who have lost loved ones, asking God to comfort those who mourn, bring healing to the injured, and strengthen all who are affected. Pray that peace will prevail over violence and extremism, and that God will protect innocent civilians. May God grant wisdom to Pakistan's leaders as they uphold justice and restore stability to the nation.

SINGAPORE

Pray for those living with dementia, that God will surround them with His love and compassion, and that they would be treated with dignity, patience and care. Remember their families and caregivers, especially those who may feel weary or overwhelmed, asking God to strengthen them, give them wisdom and patience, and sustain them in the demands of daily care. Pray also for domestic helpers who are entrusted with caring for the elderly, that they will receive the training, guidance and support they need. May God give them compassion and understanding in their daily responsibilities, and move our society to show greater care and support for those living with dementia and the families who walk alongside them.

DIOCESE

For St John's-St Margaret's Church (SJSJ), praise God for the 19 candidates who will be

baptised on 22 & 23 August. Pray that as they take this step of faith, identifying with Christ in His death and resurrection, they will be empowered to live as faithful disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ. Thank God for His faithful providential care over Heartfriends Student Care Centre (HSCC), a community service arm of SJSJ which provides supervised care after school hours for Primary 1 to Secondary 2 students, in partnership with the Tanjong Pagar Community Development Council and the Pasir Panjang Citizens' Consultative Committee. Pray that God will keep HSCC as a safe sanctuary where children learn, play and rest after school, strengthen the staff so that they may nurture each child with love and compassion, and empower SJSJ volunteers to lead programmes that sow and shape kingdom values into the hearts of the children.

Pray for our Vicar, Revd Dr Christopher Chan, as he leads the Cathedral in its ministry to our congregation and the wider community. May God grant him wisdom, strength and grace as he shepherds His people and faithfully proclaims His Word. 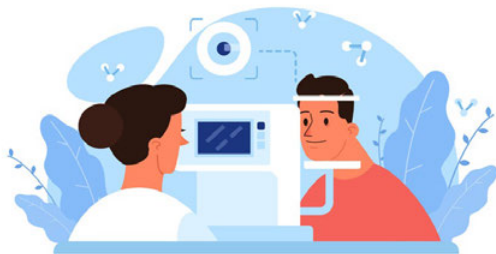
Caring for the Eyes God Has Given Us

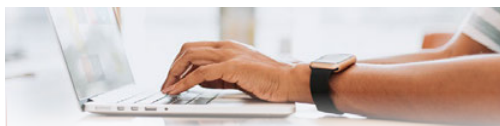

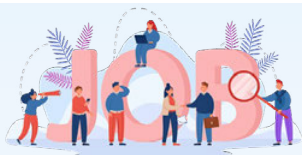
