Pray also for the churches in Malaysia, that our brothers and sisters will grow in their faith and love for the Lord, and that the Church will be a shining light and a blessing to the nation.

SINGAPORE

Pray for Singapore that our nation will remain trusted, relevant and resilient in a changing world. May the Lord guide our leaders with wisdom and sound judgement as they safeguard Singapore's interests and help our nation remain open and connected to the world. Pray also for our government, its ministries and the Civil Service as they review and implement policies for the future. Ask God to grant them wisdom and discernment, that policies will be wisely conceived and sustainable, and that our nation's resources will be used responsibly and well for the good of all Singaporeans.

DIOCESE

Pray for the Theological Education Board chaired by Archbishop The Most Revd Dr Titus Chung, that God grant them wisdom as they provide

oversight and direction for the training and discipleship needs in our Diocese. Pray for Revd Dr Joshua Sudharman, Warden of St Peter's Hall (SPH) and Director of Training, associate wardens and all who are involved in curriculum planning, organising and teaching the Lay Training and In-Service Training courses. 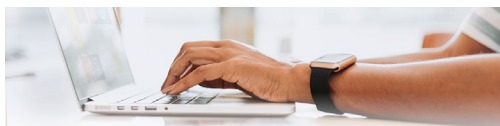
